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Financial Fasting

I am convinced that as a body of Believers, we are not taking full advantage of fasting. It has become more of a traditional and seasonal thing, rather than a principle that God has given to us to activate and manifest the supernatural power of God and expedite things in our lives. I also believe we have not understood fasting in its diverseness and have relegated it to only not eating food, leaving out the more important functions.

Fasting isn't really about what you are not eating. Fasting is really about what you choose to eat. When Jesus said, "this kind cometh out only by fasting and prayer," we know that fasting does not cast out devils. So, what was He really implying? What is missed is what led Jesus to make such comment. The disciples did not cast the devil out of the child when the man brought him to them. The man actually said they "could not," which is incorrect. They could because they were given the power to do so. But they did not because they were more conscious and focused on the activity of the demon in the child than they were of the power given to them to combat it. They were naturally engaged and spiritually out of touch. So, when Jesus made the statement of this kind being able to come out by fasting and prayer, He was dealing with them not maintaining the proper spiritual diet for this type of Kingdom manifestation. He was speaking to them not feeding themselves the right words and maintaining the right spiritual posture that keeps the power of God active in their lives, so that they are not driven by what they see but by what God said.

What fasting does is make the Believer more spiritually conscious of the power and ability they have been given of the Father, and more sensitive and engaged to the activity of that power. The purpose of

Financial Fasting is to renew the mind to God's way of thinking, believing, and doing. Romans 12:2, says *And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.* When the Believer's mind is not transformed and renewed, they will not prove [*establish the existence, truth, or validity of; to provide sufficient proof of*], God's perfect will. The disciples missed delivering the child and it angered Jesus because they had been given the power to do so; yet they provided no proof, because they did not maintain proper fasting. Well, you and I have the power of God (Holy Spirit) residing in us. We have the promise of a prosperous life. The world is watching us live this Word out – they are looking for proof. We should be providing that proof of the Word's ability to do what it says, but have our minds been renewed to God's will and God's way?

This is what fasting does. It gives us the opportunity to eat spiritual words meals without the mixing of other information, so that we get God's mind on the matter. **You are going to take 30 days to focus and feed your mind on nothing but the Word of God concerning your financial wellbeing.** Our natural mind cannot comprehend the things of God. The natural mind is against the things of God because they are foolishness unto it. To the natural mind, things need to make sense; to the spiritual mind, they only need to make faith. A lot of Believers are trying to take natural minds and manifest spiritual promises. It takes enough time in the Word, over a consistent period, to renew the mind back to the things of God.

Take this Financial Fast serious, as if your financial wellbeing depends on it. For the next 30 days, fast from all other information; you will only eat the Word. It is knowing the truth that makes you free. Knowing deals with intimacy and relationship that births more of the same. Jesus said, *"This is the bread that cometh down from Heaven, and he that eateth of this bread shall never hunger."*

30-Day Financial Fast

- Take time and meditate on each scripture (read in another translation).
- Take a scripture and convert to memory.
- Make the Financial Confession in the morning and evening.
- Journal what you hear God speaking to you.

God Wants You To Prosper

Day #1

It is the will of God that you prosper. We can come boldly to the throne of Grace for our financial needs, just like we do for all other needs in our life. Believers should be thriving in life and not living in survival mode.

Isaiah 48:17 - *Thus saith the Lord, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; I am the Lord thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go.*

Job 36:11 - *If they obey and serve Him, they shall spend their days in prosperity and their years in pleasures.*

Psalms 35:27 - *Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour My righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the Lord be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of His servant.*

Pleasure: satisfaction or enjoyment.

It brings God satisfaction when His children prosper.

Psalms 36:8-9 - *They shall be abundantly satisfied with the fatness of thy house; and thou shalt make them drink of the river of thy pleasures. ⁹ For with Thee is the fountain of life: in Thy light shall we see light.*

Abundantly: blessed, to break forth, copiously, plenty, gush forth, to flourish

Psalms 68:19 - *Blessed be the Lord, who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our salvation. Selah.*

Psalms 112:3-4 - *His seed shall be mighty upon earth: the generation of the upright shall be blessed. ³ Wealth and riches shall be in his house: and his righteousness endureth for ever.*

John 15:8 - *Herein is My Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be My disciples.*

- Biblical prosperity is not just money. The prosperity of God is whole-life prosperity.
- God is glorified; made BIG (Hebrew *hadar* - to magnify, glorify) when the Believer prospers.

I Thessalonians 5:23-24 - *And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. 24 Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it.*

Wholly: totally, all together.

Christ Jesus gained victory so that every part of your life could experience prosperity.

III John 1:2AMP - *Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in every way....*

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- It is God's will to prosper me.
- I am blessed to be a blessing.
- I thrive in life!

Kingdom Commitment

- Today, be intentional to cast down all thoughts that reject you prospering.
- Boldly confess that you are a prosperous being. It starts with faith before it becomes a fact.

Kingdom Financial Confession

I am blessed of God. I receive God's provision of being abundantly supplied. I bind lack and its power to keep me from prospering. I renew my mind to God's will and God's way. I am anointed to prosper and empowered to get wealth. Every thought that is contrary to God's will for my finances, I cast it down in the name of Christ Jesus. I now receive the God quality of life. I expect money to come into my hands, and the wisdom to steward properly.

My Covenant Right To Wealth

Day #2

We have a covenant with God, and this covenant is to every area of our lives: spirit, soul, and body. It is a promise from God to extend everything that He has for us to us. It is His Word to preserve, protect, and provide for His people.

- “I will” is often a statement in the Bible that is synonymous with Covenant. It is not just a promise to us, but a promise that God makes to Himself.

Genesis 12:2-3 - *And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing: and I will bless them that bless thee and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.*

Genesis 17:1-2 - *And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the Lord appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before Me, and be thou perfect.² And I will make My covenant between Me and thee and will multiply thee exceedingly.*

- “Almighty God” - El Shaddai; The Almighty God; The God that is more than enough; The God of Abundance

Galatians 3:13-14,29 - *Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:¹⁴ that the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.²⁹ And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.*

Hebrews 6:13-14 - *For when God made promise to Abraham, because He could swear by no greater, He sware by Himself,¹⁴ saying, Surely blessing I will bless thee, and multiplying I will multiply thee.*

Deuteronomy 8:18 - *But thou shalt remember the Lord thy God: for it is He that giveth thee power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He sware unto thy fathers, as it is this day.*

- God decided that prospering would be a sign of His covenant on our lives. When we prosper, what He established with Abraham is fulfilled.

Deuteronomy 28: 1-14 - Covenant Blessing of God

- The challenge of the times does not alter God's Covenant, but we see an enforcement of God's provision in hard times.

Psalms 33:18-19 - *Behold, the eye of the Lord is upon them that fear him, upon them that hope in his mercy; ¹⁹ to deliver their soul from death, and to keep them alive in famine.*

Psalms 37:19 - *They shall not be ashamed in the evil time: and in the days of famine, they shall be satisfied.*

Ezekiel 34:25-31 - *And I will make with them a covenant of peace, and will cause the evil beasts to cease out of the land: and they shall dwell safely in the wilderness, and sleep in the woods. ²⁶ And I will make them and the places round about my hill a blessing; and I will cause the shower to come down in his season; there shall be showers of blessing. ²⁷ And the tree of the field shall yield her fruit, and the earth shall yield her increase, and they shall be safe in their land, and shall know that I am the LORD, when I have broken the bands of their yoke, and delivered them out of the hand of those that served themselves of them. ²⁸ And they shall no more be a prey to the heathen, neither shall the beast of the land devour them; but they shall dwell safely, and none shall make them afraid. ²⁹ And I will raise up for them a plant of renown, and they shall be no more consumed with hunger in the land, neither bear the shame of the heathen any more. ³⁰ Thus shall they know that I the LORD their God am with them, and that they, even the house of Israel, are my people, saith the Lord GOD. ³¹ And ye my flock, the flock of my pasture, are men, and I am your God, saith the Lord GOD.*

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- Covenants are eternal and rely solely on the word of the one who made the Covenant.
- You are awarded the Covenant of Wealth through salvation in Christ Jesus.
- God is in covenant with you concerning your financial well-being and He obligates Himself to fulfill what He says.

Kingdom Commitment

- Release faith in God's Word to do what it says it can do.
- Rehearse what your covenant affords you instead of how it looks.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

Today, I release faith in God's covenant of wealth and prosperity over my life. Christ has redeemed me from the curse of the law, and I am free from the curse of lack. The Abrahamic Covenant is operative in my life. God swore to establish His covenant of blessings and I receive it. I am blessed to be a blessing, no longer a stranger of the covenants and blessing of God.

In the Name of Jesus, I declare that wealth and riches are in my home and my righteousness endures forever! I take my rightful stand as an heir of God and joint heir with Christ. By faith, I enforce my covenant right to blessings.

Supernatural Abundance

Day #3

When we hear the word *supernatural*, we often think of an event or an exceptional act or occurrence, but supernatural is simply living life at God's level. It was always for man to live a supernatural life, a life that is above average and beyond the ordinary. Just enough is not the Kingdom's way. God wants us to have more than enough. When Jesus led the disciples in feeding the people in John 6, they did not eat just enough. The Bible says they ate *as much as they would*, and they did not give back to the lad the initial snack that created the moment. From two fish and five barley loaves came twelve baskets of fish and loaves - **over and above**. It was the Kingdom of God superseding logic and reason.

II Corinthians 9:8 in the Amplified Version says,

And God is able to make all grace (every favor and earthly blessing) come to you in abundance, so that you may always and under all circumstances and whatever the need be self-sufficient [possessing enough to require no aid or support and furnished in abundance for every good work and charitable donation].

In departing Egypt, God said the Israelites would spoil the Egyptians. He could have easily given them just enough, but God sent them away with a supernatural abundance of more than what they needed.

Psalms 105:37 - *He brought them forth also with silver and gold: and there was not one feeble person among their tribes.*

Peter, in Luke 5, caught a boat load of fish. He caught so much that he had to beckon his partners to come and help, and they filled both ships so that they began to sink. This was after the normal way of fishing yielded no results.

The same God who did those things back then is the same God today. He is no respecter of persons, and He does not change. Jesus, being the

expressed image of God, said in John 10:10 Amplified Version, *He came so that we might have and enjoy life and have it in abundance, to the full and till it overflows.* When something overflows, it is because it has too much in it.

There is a level of abundance that is beyond what your job can produce. Heaven has a reserve for you and me, and it awaits our faith of releasing it into the earth. You can release your faith and see God do exceedingly, abundantly, above all you can ask or think. It starts with simply believing and obeying the Word of God. Everything God has given us in His Word is for life, and that life more abundantly. It's for a life that cannot be explained, but only give glory to God.

Psalms 68:19 - *Blessed be the Lord, who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our salvation. Selah.*

Loadeth {load} def. *fill-up, cram, pack, pile, stuff, stack.*

"eth" at the end of a word means *on an ongoing continual basis.*

Isaiah 43:19 - *Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert.*

Isaiah 55:1-2 - *Ho, every one that thirsteth, come ye to the waters, and he that hath no money; come ye, buy, and eat; yea, come, buy wine and milk without money and without price. ²Wherefore do ye spend money for that which is not bread? and your labour for that which satisfieth not? hearken diligently unto Me, and eat ye that which is good, and let your soul delight itself in fatness.*

Supernatural abundance means that we are not subject to the times. God exists outside of time and so does faith. Faith tells time what it's going to be. We do not live under the dominion or control of time; rather, time is subject to the authority of the Word of God. Our economy is from Heaven, and we were not put here on earth to barely survive or get by. We are to flourish no matter what is going on in the times. We always come out on top and win.

Psalms 92:14 - *They shall still bring forth fruit in old age; they shall be fat and flourishing.*

Psalms 37:19 - *They shall not be ashamed in the evil time: and in the days of famine, they shall be satisfied.*

Jeremiah 5:12 - *They have belied the Lord, and said, It is not he; neither shall evil come upon us; neither shall we see sword nor famine.*

John 17:15 - *I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil.*

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- I operate under and from a different economic system.
- I should know no lack because faith always provides.
- I should have an expectation for over and above and not just enough.

Kingdom Commitment

- Believe for more than enough.
- To speak faith filled words over my financial wellbeing.
- To not settle for the norms of life.
- Acknowledge God as the source.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

I live a prosperous, supernatural life of more than enough.

I am not subject to the times.

I am daily loaded with benefits.

I am blessed coming in and blessed going out.

My barns are full and running over.

I have more than enough to live a prosperous life to the glory of God.

I represent the Kingdom well.

I increase to increase others.

I am a wealth distributor for the Kingdom of God.

In Jesus Name, Amen.

Financial Favor

Day #4

Psalms 5:12 - *For thou, Lord, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass Him as with a shield.*

A. Favor

Definition 1: *The ability to do more with less time, less money, and half the effort.*

Definition 2: *The willingness of others to use their power, their ability, and their influence to help you.*

Definition 3: *Grace, the unmerited goodness of God. Help and provision that you do not work for.*

Definition 4: *God's good pleasure.*

1. Favor is a benefit of salvation and of being a Kingdom citizen. It is a supernatural force that allows the Believer to advance in life beyond the need and often use of natural means.

Psalms 103:2 - *Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits.*

"Benefit" def. advantage, profit, help, strength, aid.

Psalms 102:13 - *Thou shalt arise, and have mercy upon Zion, for the time to favour her, yea the set time, is come.*

2. You should have an expectation to see the favor of God on your life. God's way is that we live out of His abundance and resources by faith. When favor is exercised in your life, you can expect to see supernatural things happen. When you do not have money, let favor be your currency of exchange. Do not rely solely on what you can produce with your hands. You have the favor of God to assist you. To appreciate favor, you cannot have a timidity of others doing for you: **Luke 2:52** - *And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man.*

I Samuel 2:26 - *And the child Samuel grew on, and was in favour both with the Lord, and also with men.*

3. Favor must be activated. It is an expectation you carry as you go, that things will not be hard for you and the steps to take will be shortened on your behalf; that it will not take as much time or talent to get it done; and that people are waiting to help you. It is a perpetual state for the Believer, and the favor of God can increase in your life.

Psalms 35:27 - *Let them shout for joy and be glad, that favour my righteous cause; yea let them say continually, Let the Lord be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.*

Romans 5:2 AMP - *Through Him also we have [our] access (entrance, introduction) by faith into this grace (state of God's favor) in which we [firmly and safely] stand. And let us rejoice and exult in our hope of experiencing and enjoying the glory of God.*

4. Favor is a currency of the Kingdom of God. Favor can open doors, bring you into the company of influence, and put you in the midst of greatness that, oftentimes, money cannot do or would take a large amount to do. The favor of God is special treatment.

Isaiah 55:1-2 - *Ho, every one that thirsteth, come ye to the waters, and he that hath no money; come ye, buy, and eat; yea, come, buy wine and milk without money and without price. Wherefore do ye spend money for that which is not bread? and your labour for that which satisfieth not? hearken diligently unto me, and eat ye that which is good, and let your soul delight itself in fatness.*

Esther 2:17 - *And the king loved Esther above all the women, and she obtained grace and favour in his sight more than all the virgins; so that he set the royal crown upon her head, and made her queen instead of Vashti.*

John 1:16 AMP - *For out of His fullness (abundance) we have all received [all had a share, and we were all supplied with] one grace after*

another and spiritual blessing upon spiritual blessing and even favor upon favor and gift [heaped] upon gift.

5. The word grace in the New Testament translates to divine favor. The throne of God is called the throne of Grace. Therefore, when we approach God's throne, we are approaching the throne of divine favor.

Hebrews 4:16 AMP - *Let us then fearlessly and confidently and boldly draw near to the throne of grace (the throne of God's unmerited favor to us sinners), that we may receive mercy [for our failures] and find grace to help in good time for every need [appropriate help and well-timed help, coming just when we need it].*

Psalms 16:11 - *Thou wilt shew me the path of life; in Thy presence is fullness of joy; at Thy right hand are pleasures for evermore.*

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- You have favor as a resource of wealth.
- When you go to God in prayer, you come to a throne of grace (divine favor).
- You have more than what is physically at hand. You have a supernatural force - a currency of the Kingdom of God called favor that can produce what you need.

Kingdom Commitment

- Declare the favor of God over your life daily.
- Expect the favor of God to manifest for you.
- Show favor to others (you reap what you sow).
- When a favorable moment happens, announce it: "That's the favor of God!"

Kingdom Wealth Confession

Today, I receive divine favor. As a child of God, favor, is my covenant right. I do more with less time, less money, and half the effort. I declare the favor of God is on me; favor before me and behind me. I expect favor. Supernatural opportunity, uncommon help, and unexplainable events are happening on my behalf. By faith, I receive God's goodness,

and all grace, every favor, and earthly blessing will abound towards me, so that under all circumstances and whatever the need, I abound to every good work. I am favored of the Lord!

In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Faithful Steward

Day #5

If there is lack in an area, you must look to how well you are stewarding. Stewardship is a principle that you cannot go around. If anything is to grow or advance, it will be so because of how well it has been stewarded. If you are facing lack, it is not because God does not have it, or even because you don't have. The missing element is being a good and faithful steward.

Luke 12:42-44 - *And the Lord said, Who then is that faithful and wise steward, whom his lord shall make ruler over his household, to give them their portion of meat in due season? ⁴³ Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing. ⁴⁴ Of a truth I say unto you, that he will make him ruler over all that he hath.*

- A. It is required of the Believer that we are good stewards over what the Lord has entrusted to us.
- B. Being a faithful steward has the reward of being ruler.
- C. The one who faithfully stewards also secures their future.

Matthew 25:21 - *His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.*

- A. Faithful means to be *constant, loyal, true; steadfast.*
- B. The way we handle the least is the way we will handle the much.
- C. The way to much more and the joy of the Lord is becoming faithful in what you have now. More amplifies who you already are.

II Corinthians 6:10 - *as sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing all things.*

- A. God grants us His goodness by allowing us to partake in what belongs to Him. When we are good stewards, we are ensured that we increase with more to steward over.

- B. We are not owners; we are possessors. If we steward it properly, we should cause whatever we have in our care to increase, flourish, and multiply.

I Corinthians 4:2 - *Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful.*

- A. Stewardship is not something you choose to do or not do. Stewardship is something you are found doing.
- B. When we don't do well with the care of that which belongs to someone else, we prove we cannot care for our own. The steward test is proven by your management of what belongs to another.

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- Our development and increase come because of how well we steward.
- When we are faithful stewards, we put a demand on more.
- A steward is one who manages his affairs and the affairs of another well.
- The key to acceleration is found in stewardship.

Kingdom Commitment

- I commit to being more disciplined with my finances.
- I commit to closing all gaps of wastefulness and being faithful with the least.
- I commit to being financially accountable and not spending frivolously.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

Father, help me to become faithful and trusting in the things that You have entrusted to me. Strengthen my hands to receive wealth and manage it properly. My desire is to please you with what you have given to me, so that my financial life also brings glory to you. I receive the wisdom, knowledge, and understanding I need so that I am better in how I handle money. I lay aside slothfulness and procrastination. With Holy Spirit, I am becoming a better steward that God can trust with the wealth of the Kingdom.

In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Faith for Finances 1

Day #6

Mark 11:22-24 - *And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. ²³ For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. ²⁴ Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.*

1. Faith begins where the will of God is known. It is the will of God that we believe to manifest in our lives. Faith is what invites God's will, and it starts with believing that what the Word of God says about your life is true regardless of the current circumstance.
2. Faith is spiritual belief solely based on the Word and God's ability to back what He says. Faith requires that you believe you will receive when you pray.

Joshua 1:8 - *This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.*

III John 1:2 - *Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.*

3. God wants us to seek Him first for all our needs. He is Jehovah Jireh, the Lord who provides for everything we need. Knowing it is the will of God that you prosper, you can pray and believe God will provide financially.

John 14: 14 - *If ye shall ask any thing in My Name, I will do it.*

John 15:8 - *Herein is My Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be My disciples.*

*“**Much fruit**” more than what is needed. A supernatural, over abundant supply of.*

Hebrews 6:13-15 - *For when God made promise to Abraham, because He could swear by no greater, He swore by Himself, ¹⁴saying, Surely blessing I will bless thee, and multiplying I will multiply thee. ¹⁵And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise.*

4. The promises of God are received by faith. With our faith, we transfer from the spirit into the natural what God has promised and made available to His children.

Hebrews 11:1-2 AMP - *Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses].² For by [faith trust and holy fervor born of faith] the men of old had divine testimony borne to them and obtained a good report.*

Faith gives us the ability to manifest what God has promised us in the earth. All the promises of God are received by faith. We have the promise of a life of prosperity, that in famine we will not lack, and God will provide our every need. It is only by faith that this happens.

- A. Faith is believing in God’s ability to meet and supply every need in your life without the aid of sense realm evidence.
- B. Faith is a spiritual force that brings the unseen into the seen. Faith transfers out of Heaven what God has reserved for our use on earth.
- C. The evidence of faith is the Word -- the incorruptible seed that cannot return void.

Ephesians 1:3 - *Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:*

- D. When we discover what the Word says, we can release faith in it manifesting in our life. God’s will is to increase us more and more.

Psalms 115:14 - *The Lord shall increase you more and more, you and your children.*

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- Faith is a lifestyle and not just a moment of believing.
- Faith begins once the will of God is known. Faith starts with the Word of God.
- Faith does not need physical evidence. It is a reliance founded solely on God's ability to do what He said.
- Faith is as real as the things you see because the things seen were once in faith.

Kingdom Commitment

- Be faithful in giving to Kingdom assignments (tithes, offering, projects, ministry gifts).
- Be open to hear Holy Spirit's directions on sowing.
- Keep walking by faith and do not become governed by money.
- Keep money as a resource, and never make money a source.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

Father, You said if I ask anything in Your Name, by faith, You would do it. I receive the promise of increase and abundance over my life. Jesus became poor so that, through His poverty, I would be made rich. I boldly declare that I am blessed, and resources overtake me. I walk in abundance, I know no lack, and people are inspired to help me. Supernatural resources are coming my way. I believe to receive more than what I need so that I am blessed to live and blessed to give. Faith is now, hope is tomorrow, and I now believe that I am blessed.

Faith for Finances 2

Day #7

Hebrews 10:36AMP - *For you have need of steadfast patience and endurance, so that you may perform and fully accomplish the will of God, and thus receive and carry away [and enjoy to the full] what is promised.*

Hebrews 6:12 - *that ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.*

Faith is always in the now. **NOW faith is...** Hebrews 11:1. This means that the moment you ask, you receive. But at that point it is only a faith fact, meaning that it is a spiritual truth that has not manifested naturally. It is just as real as the natural, but it is not yet seen. This is why the Bible teaches that patience must be added to your faith. It is faith and patience that produce the promise. Because you do not see any results does not mean you do not have it. You cannot cast away your belief, confidence, or your confession. You must stay fixed on the Word and keep your confession in line with what the Word says.

Between belief and manifestation is where you must fight the good fight of faith. God is faithful to His Word. Because you do not see anything yet does not mean that nothing is happening. Your confession remains in the now: *I have; It is, God has;* etc. The language of faith is, "It is done."

Hebrews 10:35 - *Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward.*

James 1:4 - *But let patience have her perfect work that you may be perfect and entire wanting nothing.*

Faith is at work even when we cannot see it; that is why it is faith. It is substance hoped for and evidence not seen. It does not require that we see; faith only requires us to believe, and our actions align with that belief.

Romans 4:3 - *For the Scriptures tell us, "Abraham believed God, and God counted him as righteous because of his faith."*

Psalms 27:13 - *I had fainted unless I had believed to see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living.*

When Abraham had no natural hope to rely on, he relied on spiritual hope. Natural hope is having someone you can borrow the money from, or the ability to get a loan. But when you don't have natural hope, you must rely on spiritual hope. Spiritual hope is when you look outside of your ability and look to the one who is able to do exceedingly, abundantly, above all you can ask or think. The Bible says that Abraham, against hope, believed in hope that what God had promised, He was able also to perform. And because he had spiritual hope, he staggered not at what God said, but was strong in faith, giving glory to God: *And being fully persuaded that what God had promised, He was able also to perform it* - Romans 4:19-21. The result was that Abraham saw what he believed for.

Another thing you must have settled when living by faith is your relationship with God. By relationship, I mean you are righteous. You have been made righteous by Jesus Christ. Faith is not a way of us proving to God that we are good or have done good. But faith is **believing what God said as who you are and who He is**. Righteousness has been imputed on you; it is not something you work for. Righteousness is something you live out: *Even as David also describeth the blessedness of the man, unto whom God imputeth righteousness without works* - Romans 4:6. *Even as David also describeth the blessedness of the man, unto whom God imputeth righteousness without works* - Romans 5:19.

You have the power to manifest what you believe. Faith is a spiritual force, and all of Heaven gets on board when you are in faith. If the worlds were framed by faith, cannot your life? You simply need to believe: *All things are possible if thou canst believe*. God wants to see us blessed. Failure brings no glory to God. It is when your light shines and others see your good works that the Father is then glorified. Be patient! Hope to the end for the joy that shall be revealed. Remember the words of king David in Psalms 27:13, *I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living*. David then encourages us in the next verse by saying, *Wait on the Lord, be of*

good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart; wait I say on the Lord
- verse 14.

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- By faith, you have - even though it is not yet seen.
- When you are in the middle of belief and manifestation, you must control your temperament, your thoughts, and your speech.
- Do not try to make faith make sense. Faith points back to the Word as its foundation.
- If it is within your ability to do it, you don't need faith. We can obey what God asks us to do.

Kingdom Commitment

- Do not let go of your faith.
- Speak what the Word says no matter how it looks.
- Cast down every thought that will put you in opposition to what you believe.
- Let patience rule your heart and mind.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

I trust the Word of God.

I have no doubt that the Word works.

I believe what God says will come to pass.

I stand in faith to see what God says.

I cast down every work of evil and every wayward thought.

I let the peace of God rule my heart.

God is the Source 1

Day #8

John 15:1-5 - *I am the True Vine, and My Father is the Husbandman. ²Every branch in Me that beareth not fruit He taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, He purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit. ³ Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you. ⁴ Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in Me. ⁵ I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in Me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without Me ye can do nothing.*

Acts 17:28 - *For in Him we live, and move, and have our being; as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also His offspring.*

I Thessalonians 5:23-24 - *And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. ²⁴ Faithful is He that calleth you, who also will do it.*

God is the source for the Christian. He is first, and nothing is to take His place. On today's financial fast, you want to take a personal observation of yourself to see if Christ is Lord over your life as your financial source. Who or what do you look to as the source of where your increase lies? God gave us work. Adam was assigned the work of dressing and keeping the garden, but it was the source that put him in the garden. Then, the source gave Him the work assignment. It was God, the source, that put him in the place and gave him what needed to be done. So, Adam was to always look to God as the source, and to the garden as only a resource.

Haggai 2:8 - *The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, saith the Lord of hosts.*

Psalms 24:1 - *The earth is the Lord's and the fullness thereof, the world and they that dwell therein.*

When something is the source of your life, it should have the ability to produce and reproduce independent of itself. The light is not the source, neither is the outlet. The job is not even the source. It is how God chose to get resources to you. The branch is nothing by itself. Its source is the tree. The greater the tree, the greater the branches. When we remain connected to the true source of prosperity, we can be a greater resource of it and it to us.

1. Whatever is first in your life lords your life in that area. Finances are not the source. God gave us finances as a resource.

Matthew 6:24 - *No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.*

Psalms 62:10 - *Place no trust in extortion, or false hope in stolen goods. If your riches increase, do not set your heart upon them.*

2. Put no trust in riches. Trust in God! To trust in means to rely upon. Money has no life within itself to give, so we cannot trust in riches.

Psalms 52:7-9 - *Lo, this is the man that made not God his strength; but trusted in the abundance of his riches, and strengthened himself in his wickedness. ⁸ But I am like a green olive tree in the house of God: I trust in the mercy of God for ever and ever. ⁹ I will praise thee for ever, because thou hast done it: and I will wait on thy name; for it is good before thy saints.*

I Timothy 6:17 - *Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy.*

Psalms 20:7 - *Some trust in and boast of chariots and some of horses, but we will trust in and boast of the name of the Lord our God.*

Proverbs 23:5 - *Wilt thou set thine eyes upon that which is not? for riches certainly make themselves wings; they fly away as an eagle toward heaven.*

3. The way to increase is faithfulness.

Proverbs 28:20 - *A faithful man shall abound with blessings: but he that maketh haste to be rich shall not be innocent.*

Matthew 25:21 - *His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.*

4. You know what the source of your life is by what means the most to you and by what you do first with your increase.

Matthew 6:33 - *But seek ye first the Kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.*

Proverbs 3:9 - *Honour the Lord with thy substance, and with the firstfruits of all thine increase.*

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- God is the Believer's source.
- Whatever you deem as your source, it should have the ability to provide, protect, and restore.
- Do not confuse resource with source or you will put first what should not be.

Kingdom Commitment

- To always put God first.
- To always honor God with the first fruit of your increase.
- To keep money as a resource and not the source.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

Father, You are Alpha and Omega. I trust in You with all my heart, and I lean not to my own understanding. In all my ways, I acknowledge You, and You direct my steps and make plain the path that I should take. Some trust in riches and gold, but I trust the name of the Lord. I put You first in all I do, for it is in You that I live, and move, and have my being. You are my source, help, and strength. Because of this, I am abundantly supplied, and I know no lack. You are the God that is more than enough and the source of all my needs. I lack for nothing. You

cause all grace to abound towards me so that I am abundantly supplied for all good work. The earth is Yours and all that is within; therefore, I am continually connected to the source of life and abundance. Thank You, Father, for causing me to increase more and more.

God is the Source 2

Day #9

Philippians 4:17 - *Not because I desire a gift: but I desire fruit that may abound to your account.*

When something is your source, there is a belief and trust in its ability to do and perform. Therefore, without reservation, the person does what is needed to get from the source what it can give. Many Believers claim God as their source, but do not carry out the guidelines that the Source has given to see His provision manifest.

God often manifests on the other side of our obedience. Fruit is on the other side of the seed, though in it at the same time. The seed must leave the natural environment and become unseen for a while, only to come back and produce what was in it the entire time. This is what Paul meant. He was letting them know that although you see me receiving, it is seed to me, and what you have released will return as fruit abounding to you. Therefore, God says He gives seed, not fruit, to the sower. The source provides the ability for resource. If you do not have God as the source, you are looking to resources as the provider.

Genesis 14:17-23 AMP - *After his [Abram's] return from the defeat and slaying of Chedorlaomer and the kings who were with him, the king of Sodom went out to meet him at the Valley of Shaveh, that is, the King's Valley. ¹⁸ Melchizedek king of Salem [later called Jerusalem] brought out bread and wine [for their nourishment]; he was the priest of God Most High, ¹⁹ And he blessed him and said, Blessed (favored with blessings, made blissful, joyful) be Abram by God Most High, Possessor and Maker of heaven and earth, ²⁰ And blessed, praised, and glorified be God Most High, Who has given your foes into your hand! And [Abram] gave him a tenth of all [he had taken]. ²¹ And the king of Sodom said to Abram, give me the persons and keep the goods for yourself. ²² But Abram said to the king of Sodom, I have lifted up my hand and sworn to the Lord, God Most High, the Possessor and Maker of heaven and earth, ²³ That I would not take a*

thread or a shoelace or anything that is yours, lest you should say, I have made Abram rich.

Abram was presented with an amazing opportunity to be enriched, but he knew it was not coming from the source. The credit of being rich would have been given to the other kings, acknowledging them as the source. Abram's reply, the father of faith, sets the standard of who supplies all his needs. He said he has *lifted up his hands unto the Lord*. Are your hands lifted? This is an important key,

We lift hands to the source. We hold out hands to the resource.

You and I should never be found lifting our hands to resources and holding out our hands to the source. Remember, He supplies all our needs according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. When your hands are lifted to resources, you have made mammon your god. This means you are dictated by resources. The problem with being ruled by resources is that you are not at the disposal of being used by God. You can only do based on what you have, when it is His riches in glory that determine what we can and cannot do.

Mark 10:17-22 - The rich young ruler missed the enjoyment of eternal life (the fullness of life while on earth) because he was ruled by resources. He asked for the enjoyment of life, but after learning that it came from being generous, he went away grieved because he had great possessions. Actually, possessions had him. You should never let go of the source. You will always be held responsible for letting go and managing resources.

Luke 12:16-22 - The rich fool saw his increase as his source. He built bigger barns and put his soul's rest in what he had stored up. He died and enjoyed none of it. Though rich, the Bible says he was a fool because he was not rich in his relationship to God.

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- The source always comes first.
- You always work from source to resource.

- The source provides the ability for resources.

Kingdom Commitment

- Only lift my hands to God.
- See prospering only as a resource for God to work through me.
- Seek first the Kingdom of God.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

God is the source of my life.

I lift my hands to God and not to riches.

As I increase, I give unto the Lord, my source, with the first fruit of my increase.

Because the Lord is my source, my hands are anointed to prosper and every place the soles of my feet tread produces resource for me.

Because I am rich towards God, I lack in no good thing.

I richly enjoy all things because I trust in God and not riches.

Favor abounds in my life, and I am enriched in everything to all bountifulness, so that I can be generous and bring forth thanksgiving to God.

Your Heavenly Account

Day #10

Deuteronomy 28:12 - *The Lord shall open unto thee His good treasure, the Heaven to give the rain unto thy land in His season, and to bless all the work of thine hand: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not borrow.*

Ezekiel 34:25-27 - *And I will make with them a covenant of peace, and will cause the evil beasts to cease out of the land: and they shall dwell safely in the wilderness, and sleep in the woods. ²⁶ And I will make them and the places round about my hill a blessing; and I will cause the shower to come down in his season; there shall be showers of blessing. ²⁷ And the tree of the field shall yield her fruit, and the earth shall yield her increase, and they shall be safe in their land, and shall know that I am the Lord, when I have broken the bands of their yoke, and delivered them out of the hand of those that served themselves of them.*

Philippians 4:19 - *But my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.*

Ephesians 1:3 - *Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in Heavenly places in Christ.*

Heaven is not only a blessed place and the future home of the saints, but also a place where the wealth of the Kingdom for ministry and personal needs abides. Our earthly needs, though supplied in earth, are distributed to us from Heaven. Heaven far exceeds just the place where we go when we leave this corruptible body. Jesus looked back to His homeland for resource and, as a result, He always had His earthly needs met. We are a part of the Heavenly family of God, *of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named*- Ephesians 3:15. You have an account in Heaven reserved just for you. You cannot make light of your Heavenly account. We can withdraw from God's

overwhelming abundance of grace. This Heavenly account is for your benefit in the earth.

Hebrews 4:16 - *Let us then fearlessly and confidently and boldly draw near to the throne of grace (the throne of God's unmerited favor to us sinners), that we may receive mercy [for our failures] and find grace to help in good time for every need [appropriate help and well-timed help, coming just when we need it].*

You are a part of a Kingdom that you do not have to look outside of for help. You have the resources you need within it, but it takes faith to believe and act on for you to see it.

Luke 12:

v. 29- *And seek not ye what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink, neither be ye of doubtful mind.*

- Need is not first; direction is. When we go after need on our own accord, Jehovah Jireh, the Lord who provides for all our need, is left out. A man's ways are right in his own eyes, but the Lord directs his steps. We have an already full Heavenly account that we can and should withdraw from.
- Seek Him, not things.

v. 30- *For all these things do the nations of the world seek after: and your Father knoweth that ye have need of these things.*

- We who are the Kingdom do not have to seek after things as though we have no hope of supply. We are forever connected to the source, who knows what we have need of, and is able and willing to supply.

v. 31- *But rather seek ye the Kingdom of God; and all these things shall be added unto you.*

- The grocery store has groceries. The name clarifies what it provides. God's name is Jehovah Jireh, the Lord God who provides all our need, the God of supply. His name is also El Shaddai, the God of Abundance, the God that is more than enough. Another

name is Abba Father, which means Daddy God. Just as a father understands that it is his sole responsibility to care for his children, God takes the same approach when it comes to us. So, He says seek me first. Come to the source first. Take of what I have already stored up for you. We should never go after things. We go after God, and He adds things.

v. 33-34 - *Sell that ye have and give alms; provide yourselves bags which wax not old, a treasure in the heavens that faileth not, where no thief approacheth, neither moth corrupteth. For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.*

- We can also determine how our Heavenly account looks. The true measure of blessing is the work that yields unto your eternal account, and not just to what you do and have naturally.
- Everything we do in earth testifies on our behalf in Heaven. There is an eternal weight of glory to be obtained along with everlasting life. God gives us eternal life, but you and I determine the weight of glory we will experience.

Malachi 3:10-12 - *Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the Lord of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it. ¹¹ And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the Lord of hosts. ¹² And all nations shall call you blessed: for ye shall be a delightsome land, saith the Lord of hosts.*

1. When you tithe you:
 - A. Open the windows of Heaven to pour you out blessings.
 - B. Protect your money under God's protection by rebuking the devourer.
 - C. Cause your ground to flourish.
 - D. Bring recognition and influence.

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- Realize you do not have a need that has not been thought out and supplied for through God.
- You have a Heavenly account that you store up in and from that same account you make withdrawals.
- You have a covenant to petition God for a response of Heaven's best.
- You are in the family of Heaven.
- Faith makes manifest what Heaven has stored up.

Kingdom Commitment

- To seek God first in all things.
- To store up in my heavenly account.
- Commit to being a faithful tither, so that I have the insurance of Heaven backing me.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

I receive Heaven's best for my life.

I seek first Your Kingdom and Your righteousness, and all things are added unto me.

The windows of Heaven blessing is manifesting in my life, and I have all sufficiency in all things.

God gives me richly all things to enjoy.

I honor God with the first fruit of all my increase, because He is my Source and the Sustainer of my life.

I purpose to be a giver and live a life of generosity.

My basket and barns are full and running over, and I am always rich towards God.

Believe For More

Day #11

Ephesians 3:30 - *Now unto him that is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us.*

Isaiah 48:17 - *Thus saith the Lord, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; I am the Lord thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go.*

Psalms 2:8 - *Ask of Me, and I shall give thee the heathen for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession.*

Mark 9:23 - *Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth*

The level of your receiving is not on God, but on your level of faith to believe. The lack is never on God. God gives us richly all things to enjoy. He does not want us to have just enough. Just enough is outside of His character. He is the God of abundance.

Luke 5:6-7 - Peter was told to cast nets, but he only cast one net. There were still many fish to catch. The net represented his belief.

II Kings 4:1-7 - The oil only stopped because there were no more vessels to pour into.

II Kings 13:17-19 - The king of Israel only struck the arrows three times. Had he destroyed them in belief, he would have utterly destroyed his enemies the same.

Mark 4:20 - Thirty, sixty, 100-fold is the Word manifesting at the level of the person's belief, not God's giving.

Jesus did not come so that we might just have life. He came so that we might have life and that life more abundantly. The Amplified Bible says *to the full, till it overflows* - John 10:10. When something overflows, that means it's too much. God wants you to have too much.

This means you can believe for more. And not just more, but much more. Apostle I. V Hilliard says, "God can afford our dreams and you could never ask God for too much." He is the Almighty God, the God of Abundance, the God of more than enough.

John 6:11-12 - When Jesus fed the people, they did not just eat enough. They ate as much as they would and there were twelve baskets left over. God is extravagant but He is not wasteful.

- Phillip had a *not enough* mindset. He reasoned with the ability to feed the people based on what he had, and not in God's ability to provide. Jesus asked to prove them because He already knew what He would do. Jesus knew that He could believe the Father for more than what was needed to feed the people.

Luke 5:6-7 - Peter did not catch just enough fish. He caught a boat load of fish. So much that he had to call his partners over to help with gathering the load.

- There was more left than caught because Peter only let down one net, when he was told nets. Yet, God still gave out of His ability even though there was no ability to handle it.

In both instances, Jesus is the one giving the order. And in both examples, more than what was needed was provided.

1. God told Abraham He was the God of Abundance and to walk before Him and be thou perfect - Genesis 17:1. We are Abraham's seed, heirs according to the promise, and we walk in his steps of faith. God was not telling Abraham to be perfect in action. What God was telling Abraham was that with Him leading his life as the Almighty, he would experience a life blameless and complete. These words are parallel with our New Testament word salvation.
2. The purpose of believing for more is so that you can live out God's covenant of why He wants us rich (abundantly supplied). It is so that we are blessed to live and blessed to give. We should be in the position of willing to communicate and ready to distribute. These are the Biblical qualifications and orders to those who are rich in

this world. However, this is an impossible order to accomplish with only just enough.

3. Believing for more becomes a problem when the motive is wrong. It is the wrong motive if you are only asking for self, and it is also the wrong motive if you ask for just enough: *Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts - James 4:3.* God's will is blessed to live and blessed to give. Abundance should always be moving through you and not just for you.

Your ability to believe is your greatest asset. The children of Israel did not enter the promise because of their unbelief. Even with proof in hand, their will hindered their belief. The land exemplified the quality-of-life God wanted them to have and live. This land was not prepared with just enough. It provided more than what they needed.

This same promise awaits us, and the Bible says that through unbelief, we, too, can come short of it: *Let us therefore fear, lest, a promise being left us of entering into his rest, any of you should seem to come short of it. ² For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it. ¹¹ Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief - Hebrews 11:1-2,11.*

You will always view and respond to a situation at the level of your belief. You will also receive from God based on the level of your believing. God does not limit us; our belief does. If God limited us, He would also limit Himself. It is through us that He reaches the world.

Believe for more!

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- It is not against the will of God to believe for more.
- You are going to have life at the level of your ability to believe.
- Realize that your ability to believe is your greatest asset.
- Understand that the key to believing for more is being a giver.

Kingdom Commitment

- Commit to being a giver.
- Increase your belief for more so that you can do more.
- Not limiting God by limiting self.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

My God can do exceedingly, abundantly, above all I can ask or think. Jesus is the Bread of Life, and He came that I might have life and that life more abundantly - to the full and till it overflows. I am overflowing with increase, so that I might give to those in need of help. God is glorified when I bear much fruit. My baskets and barns are full. My storehouses are running over, and I have more than enough. I receive the 100-fold return on my giving, and I increase at an overflowing, accelerated level. Because Jesus is the Bread of Life, I never hunger, thirst, or lack for any good thing.

In Jesus' Name, Amen.

The Blessing of the Lord

Day #12

Galatians 3:13-14 - *Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: ¹⁴ that the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.*

It is The Blessing. The blessing is not wealth or things. The blessing is an empowerment placed on the life of the born-again Believer to get wealth and resources when needed. This is a benefit of being an heir and joint heir in the kingdom of God.

Proverbs 10:22 - *The blessing of the Lord, it maketh rich, and He addeth no sorrow with it.*

Amplified Bible - *The blessing of the Lord - it makes [truly] rich, and He adds no sorrow with it [neither does toiling increase it].*

God has empowered the Christians to get wealth, and to do so without stress, strain, or struggle - without having to chase money, things, or becoming a servant to mammon.

Deuteronomy 28:12 - *The Lord shall open unto thee His good treasure, the Heaven to give the rain unto thy land in his season, and to bless all the work of thine hand: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not borrow*

Proverbs 10:4 - *He becometh poor that dealeth with a slack hand: but the hand of the diligent maketh rich.*

John 15:16 - *Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in My name, He may give it you.*

There is an anointing on the Christian's life that gives them the ability to increase amid any circumstance. You have access to the blessing without restraint. This is why no Believer should suffer lack. They have the blessing on their life, which translates to the ability to get wealth whenever and wherever.

Genesis 26:12 - Isaac sowed in the midst of famine, and in the same year reaped a hundredfold. And the Lord blessed him.

Psalms 34:10 NLT - *Even strong young lions sometimes go hungry, but those who trust in the Lord will lack no good thing.*

- The Believer can live a life without lack. Jesus never lacked. He activated the blessing, even for others. When the 5,000 were hungry, Jesus lifted the fish and loaves, and they multiplied. When they needed to pay their taxes, Jesus ordered Peter to cast a hook in the water and there would be a fish with gold in its mouth for the payment. He activated the blessing. When things seem financially difficult, our first response should be the activating of the blessing.

Luke 22:35 - *And he said unto them, When I sent you without purse, and scrip, and shoes, lacked ye any thing? And they said, Nothing.*

I Thessalonians 4:12 AMP - *So that you may bear yourselves becomingly and be correct and honorable and command the respect of the outside world, being dependent on nobody [self-supporting] and having need of nothing*

The blessing is activated through our giving coupled with our declaration. Nothing happens in the earth without a seed. Even if a person sows, the fulfillment of it happens through seed. Isaac sowed in the midst of the famine. During a time when most would save and cut back, Isaac activated the blessing and reaped. This means that the blessing is not under the control of earthly things. It is a Kingdom power solely backed by Heaven.

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- The blessing is on the life of every Believer to activate and manifest the prosperity they need in life.
- Every born-again Believer is empowered to prosper.
- You can live a life of no lack.
- God has anointed you to prosper.

Kingdom Commitment

- Move from the spirit into the natural.
- Activate the blessing.
- Declare the outcome you desire, not the problem you see.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

I am anointed to prosper.

The Blessing of Abraham is on my life.

I am empowered by God to do more with less time, less money, and half the effort.

Money comes to me in abundance.

Even in hard times, I prosper!

I shall lack no good thing.

Because of the blessing, I am not dependent on anyone [self-supporting] and have need of nothing.

In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Command Your Money

Day #13

Job 22:27-28 - *Thou shalt make thy prayer unto him, and he shall hear thee, and thou shalt pay thy vows.* ²⁸ *Thou shalt also decree a thing, and it shall be established unto thee: and the light shall shine upon thy ways.*

Verse 28 NLT - *You will succeed in whatever you **choose to do**, and light will shine on the road ahead of you.*

A decree is an *official order issued by a legal authority.*

God has given you authority in the earth. We govern earth's affairs under the Federal Lordship of Christ Jesus. One way that governing power is executed is through what we say. Our words play a huge role in the outcome of our day-to-day life and the results we see and experience in life. When God put the earth back to how He created it, He spoke. And when He spoke, He saw what He spoke. He then created man in His image - as a spirit-being first. The first thing we see from God is that He decrees to see. Romans 4:17 says, *Even God who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were.* God called the earth back to what it was in the beginning. And when He created man, He gave unto man the very same creative power to call things in life as though they were. You must speak what the Word of God says over your finances. You cannot claim being broke and rich. The New Living Translation says that your words choose what you will do. You must decree that you are blessed. Abraham was calling himself the father of many nations long before he had any proving evidence. He did not wait until he was living out the name Abraham (father of many nations), to call himself a father. You do not have to wait until you have prosperity to command prosperity. Your declaration of what God says you are causes it to manifest in your life.

Mark 10:22-24 - *And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.* ²³ *For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this*

mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. ²⁴ Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

- Notice the mountain moves at the command of your voice. It also says you will have whatsoever you saith. That “eth” means on an ongoing, continual basis.
- The scripture says it is a mountain, and then says that the mountain is things. Money is a thing. The Scripture is teaching us the importance of using our words - the Word of God to manifest what God has promised in our lives.

Matthew 12:37 - *For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.*

1. Our words have creative power. They can either curse us or bless us. We live in a world that is governed by words. It is the confession of faith that saves us. In that same way, through confession we release our faith for financial increase. Faith must be exercised when it comes to receiving from God, and it is demonstrated by the words you speak. You must call your harvest in by faith.

Hebrews 11:3 - *Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.*

Matthew 16:19 - *And I will give unto thee the keys of the Kingdom of Heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.*

Psalms 103:20 - *Bless the Lord, ye His angels, that excel in strength, that do His commandments, hearkening unto the voice of His Word.*

2. Earth exists, the heavens function, angels minister, hearken and obey, and the kingdom of darkness is bound and defeated from the words we speak. Your life, which includes your finances, is as well.

When the Word is spoken over your finances, you change the trajectory of your finances. God's Word has the power to change anything; it is sharper than any two-edge sword. It is from the Word that you receive the model of how you should be in the earth. In Him we live, move, and have our being. So, if anything is not like Him, by faith we must speak it until things change, along with corresponding actions.

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- You have a promise to wealth and riches, but the promises of God are received by faith. The Word of Faith is what we speak.
- You will have what you say.
- You determine what you receive from God based on the Word you speak. Death and life are in the power of your tongue.

Kingdom Commitment

- Only speak the Word over my finances.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

I speak increase over my finances. I call the resources of the Kingdom. I command my ministering angels to go now and bring wealth. I decree that my needs are met, I'm out of debt, and I have plenty more to put up in store. Money cometh to me, now! I receive my covenant right to wealth and riches, and my righteousness endures forever. As a joint heir with Christ, I walk in the blessing of more than enough. I now loose the prosperity that has been stored up for me in heavenly places. I resist lack and receive only abundance in my life.

A Heart to Prosper

Day #14

II Corinthians 9:10-11 MSG - *This most generous God who gives seed to the farmer that becomes bread for your meals is more than extravagant with you. He gives you something you can then give away, which grows into full-formed lives, robust in God, wealthy in every way, so that you can be generous in every way, producing with us great praise to God.*

NLT - *Yes, you will be enriched in every way so that you can always be generous. And when we take your gifts to those who need them, they will thank God.*

Mark 6:19-21 - *Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: 20 but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal: 21 for where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.*

The desire of every Believer should be to be spiritually rich first. Spiritually rich is the understanding that you are rich in God through Christ Jesus. And from being spiritually rich, we are materially prosperous. This way, the Believer has the right heart for being prosperous. Prospering is more than a material issue; it's a heart issue, because if your heart is not right concerning prosperity, you become a servant to mammon. God makes us materially wealthy so that we can function in being generous, not just so we can heap things upon ourselves. This is not a matter of having things, but it's a tell-tale of the heart.

God does not mind us prospering. If He did, He would not have said, *Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession* - Psalms 2:8. *A good man leaveth an inheritance to his children's children: and the wealth of the sinner is laid up for the just* - Proverbs 13:22. You can't be against wealth and say we should leave an inheritance, and

that the wealth of the sinner is for the just. What God wants is for us to have the right heart posture for having prosperity.

1. Our heart's motivation for prosperity should be from a heart to advance the Kingdom of God.

Exodus 35:20-21,36:7 - *20 And all the congregation of the children of Israel departed from the presence of Moses. 21 And they came, every one whose heart stirred him up, and every one whom his spirit made willing, and they brought the Lord's offering to the work of the tabernacle of the congregation, and for all his service, and for the holy garments. 7 - For the stuff they had was sufficient for all the work to make it, and too much.*

There are projects that need financing so that the lost and unsaved can have the Gospel of the Kingdom extended to them. But those are delayed or do not advance at the rate they should because those with prosperity do not have God's heart as to why they are blessed.

I Chronicles 29 - King David sowed an offering of what some have totaled to be 65 million dollars for the building of the temple. And after giving glory to God, he compelled the people to give also. And the Bible says that they gave cheerfully and with joy and blessed the Lord. The building of Solomon's Temple was resourced by the people of God.

Galatians 6:10 NLT - *Therefore, whenever we have the opportunity, we should do good to everyone - especially to those in the family of faith.*

2. Our heart's motivation for prospering is so that we can have the integrity of paying our bills and debts on time.

Romans 13:8 - *Owe no man any thing, but to love one another: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law.*

3. Our heart's motivation for prospering should not be to heap riches unto ourselves for selfish motives, title, or for the proof of one's success.

Luke 12:15 - *And He said unto them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: for a man's life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth.*

4. Our heart's motivation for prospering is so that we are ready for God to use us for His glory.

Genesis 12:2 - *And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing.*

I Timothy 6:17-18 - *Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy; 18 that they do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate.*

Luke 10:30-37 - The Good Samaritan had enough resources to take care of the man that fell among thieves and was left nearly dead. With his resources, he bandaged his wounds, fed him, and gave him a place to stay for as long as he needed. Jesus called this man a neighbor unto him.

5. A right heart motivation for prospering allows us to enjoy the good of the land and leave an inheritance for the next generation.

Ecclesiastes 5:18-19 - *Behold that which I have seen: it is good and comely for one to eat and to drink, and to enjoy the good of all his labour that he taketh under the sun all the days of his life, which God giveth him: for it is his portion. ¹⁹ Every man also to whom God hath given riches and wealth, and hath given him power to eat thereof, and to take his portion, and to rejoice in his labour; this is the gift of God.*

Proverbs 13:22 - *A good man leaveth an inheritance to his children's children. and the wealth of the sinner is laid up for the just.*

With the right heart of prospering, we should be feeding the poor, clothing the naked, and sheltering the homeless. Jesus said when you do this unto the least of them, you have done also unto Him.

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- The right heart posture is critical to being prosperous.
- When you have the right heart, God prospers you.
- The heart of prospering is so that you can finance God's Kingdom agenda and do good to others.
- A heart of prospering must have more than self in mind.

Kingdom Commitment

- Develop the right heart posture for having prosperity by starting now with what I have, so that more amplifies who I already am.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

Father, help me to have the right heart posture concerning prosperity. I submit my finances over to you, and I trust Holy Spirit to guide me in the way I should go and the handling of my financial affairs. I fix my heart on pleasing You first and doing what is right in Your eyesight. I am blessed to live and blessed to give.

In Jesus' Name, Amen.

The Love of God

Day #15

Psalms 115:12-15 - *The Lord hath been mindful of us: He will bless us; He will bless the house of Israel; He will bless the house of Aaron. ¹³ He will bless them that fear the Lord, both small and great. ¹⁴ The Lord shall increase you more and more, you and your children. ¹⁵ Ye are blessed of the Lord which made heaven and earth.*

I John 4:8-9 - *In this is manifested the love of God towards us, because that God sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him. Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us, and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.*

The love of God is still one of the most misunderstood components of our relationship with God. And the reason being is because we often filter our understanding of love through ourselves, rather than taking on our understanding of love simply from what God says. It is from this very simple understanding that life opens to an entirely new meaning and even the understanding of the purpose of life in God.

Hebrews 11:6 - *But **without faith it is impossible to please Him:** for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him.*

Galatians 5:6 - *For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but **faith which worketh by love.***

The foundation of the Bible rests on God's love. Every punishment that Jesus endured, including the Cross, was because of God's love for you. For love's sake, you have been anointed to prosper. We did not choose God or find God. He was never lost; we were. God chose us! And He chose to love us in spite of. There should never be a question of whether God loves you. If so, faith is hindered. And if faith is hindered, manifestation is delayed.

Where there is a question of love, there will always be the question of deserving. This then removes love from God giving freely onto the basis of a merit that you work to deserve. And if that merit isn't met, then you are not loved by God; thus, you cannot receive God's promises or blessings. This is not the order of God or how the love of God works. God has freely loved us. The Bible says, *But God commended His love towards us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us* - Romans 5:8. It was not being right that earned the merit of God's love; it was God loving us. *We love Him because He first loved us* - I John 4:19.

1. The love of God is made perfect in our boldness to believe. When we have boldness of knowing God loves us, we manifest Jesus in us.

I John 4:16-17 - *And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him. Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world.*

- What would change in your belief, your faith, and your receiving if you knew without question that God loves you? What would change if you knew you did not have to do anything to earn it, and you could never lose it?

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- God's love is demonstrated towards me in His Son.
- The foundation of the Bible and the working of faith is love.
- I am loved by God.

Kingdom Commitment

- To receive God's love without conditions attached.
- To know I am loved of God and because of His love, He blesses me.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

I am loved by God.

Your love surrounds me like a shield.

The love of God fills life and every space in my heart.

No matter what it looks like, or what I do, You love me still.

Father, I receive Your unconditional, unfailing, never-ending love!

In the Mighty Name of Christ Jesus, Amen.

Money Cometh Now!

Day #16

Ephesians 2:5 - *Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved).*

God does not have a money problem. Heaven is not empty and never runs out: *The earth is the Lord's and the fullness thereof.* As a member in the body of Christ, God makes it His responsibility to take care of His own. This means Heaven is always at hand. The place of supply to the Church is ready to supply the need when we need it.

When being tempted on the Cross about not being able to help Himself, Jesus said He could call a legion of angels and they would show up immediately to His aid. Hebrews 1:14 teaches that you have that same ability and angelic help on standby waiting to minister for you. This angelic help is not limited to trouble. They are there to minister for you for any need you might have, including your finances.

Ephesians 2:12-13 - *That at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world: ¹³ But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ.*

- What we were without Christ, we have now become because of Christ.
 1. We are no more aliens (separated) from the commonwealth of Israel. Wealth was not a foreign thing to the people of God, because they had the source of wealth.
 2. We are no longer strangers (outsiders) from the Covenant and promises of God.

Promise

Hebrews 6:13-14 - *For when God made promise to Abraham, because He could swear by no greater, He swore by Himself,¹⁴ saying, Surely blessing I will bless thee, and multiplying I will multiply thee.*

Covenant

Deuteronomy 8:18 - *But thou shalt remember the Lord thy God: for it is He that giveth thee power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore unto thy fathers, as it is this day.*

We have both covenant and promise that God will provide kingdom resources for our home. And God is not a man that He should lie, neither the son of man that He should repent. You must believe that money cometh when you need it and, out of your mouth, declare back to God what He promised to do.

Isaiah 43:26 - *Put me in remembrance: let us plead together: declare thou, that thou mayest be justified.*

The righteous are never forsaken, nor does His seed beg for bread. God is the source, and He will never have you reliant upon anyone else to take His position of provision. The same faith you believe with for healing, is the same faith you believe with to prosper. Money answers, too! You must claim your Kingdom inheritance of more than enough. The riches of the Kingdom are yours to have. There are spiritual blessings laid up for you in heavenly places, and you have to lose them on earth so that they are loosed in Heaven. Faith is the key that unlocks the door of more than enough. Faith makes the withdrawal from Heaven. If you need more resources, you must make the withdrawal. Yes, God knows what we need. That is why He has made the provision ready before we need it. However, that need is met through our faith.

Matthew 9:29 - *Then touched He their eyes, saying, **According to your faith be it unto you.***

1. You must deposit in order to make a demand on a withdrawal.

Luke 12:33 - *Sell that ye have, and give alms; provide yourselves bags which wax not old, a treasure in the heavens that faileth not, where no thief approacheth, neither moth corrupteth.*

Mathew 6:19-20 - *Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: 20 but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal.*

Mark 10:21 - *Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow me.*

Philippians 4:17,19 - *Not because I desire a gift: but I desire fruit that may abound to your account. ¹⁹ But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.*

2. When you tithe, you secure and move yourself off the world's system.

Malachi 3:10-12 - *Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the Lord of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it. ¹¹ And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the Lord of hosts. ¹² And all nations shall call you blessed: for ye shall be a delightsome land, saith the Lord of hosts.*

The currency of the Kingdom is yours. God does not need the cattle on a thousand hills, silver, or gold. He has these things in store for us, so that when there is an earthly need, Heaven, the Embassy for the Church, can provide. Make your requests known unto God.

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- There are riches stored up and waiting to be released in the earth to God's people.
- Heaven is the resource center to the Body of Christ.
- Your confession of faith releases prosperity into your life.

Kingdom Commitment

- Speak blessing over my finances and not lack.
- Seek God as the source and receive what God has promised.
- Store up in my Heavenly account by tithing and giving.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

According to Ephesians 2:12-13, I declare that I am not estranged to the commonwealth of Israel or the covenants or promises of God. I lack no good thing! According to my covenant promise of Deuteronomy 28:11, I am plenteous in goods, in my body, my purpose, and in my resources. My storehouses are running over, and my baskets and barns are full. I resist lack! I have more than enough. Money cometh to me now! I agree with the Word that God giveth me richly all things to enjoy.

By faith, I make withdrawals from my Heavenly account. I loose my ministering angels to go now and minister to me in my financial wellbeing, and to bring resources and people with resources my way. I thank You, Father, for supplying my needs according to your riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Living Debt Free

Day #17

Romans 13:8 AMP - *Keep out of debt and owe no man anything, except to love one another; for he who loves his neighbor [who practices loving others] has fulfilled the Law [relating to one's fellowmen, meeting all its requirements].*

Al debt is not bad, and debt is not a sin. If debt were a sin, God could not make you a lender because you would cause people to sin by the hand of God.

Bad debt is debt that does not allow or restricts you from being blessed to live and give. Bad debt entraps you in living paycheck to paycheck or having to find extra sources of income for the sole purpose of making up the difference. Debt is also not a spirit. You cannot rebuke debt. Poverty, on the other hand, can be rebuked. Debt is the outcome of poor stewardship or the lack of self-discipline or budgeting.

There are two ways Romans 13:8 can be viewed:

1. ***Keep out of debt and owe no man anything, except to love one another.*** The context of the scripture is dealing with paying your debts. Therefore, if you owe a debt or bill that is to be paid on the 1st of the month and you pay the debt/bill, then you owe no man nothing but to love him. You have fulfilled your agreement of payment until the next time of payment.
2. ***Keep out of debt and owe no man anything, except to love one another.*** You can live debt free where everything you own is paid for. The land of Canaan that was promised to God and, according to Hebrews 4, was the Gospel preached unto them. In that land, the Children of Israel would have been debt free. Their job was to manage and keep – the same assignment given to Adam. That very

same assignment, I believe, is still for the church today. We should be managing and keeping the resources of the kingdom of God.

Our church's bank representative is always in awe at our books. We get yearly audits, and we have no debt on the books. He always encourages that debt is not bad, and that we can get loans for things and not spend cash for everything. Personally, there is just something I love about not being in debt. His reply is, "Your savings would look better." He cannot wrap his head around how we do what we do. It is because we have taken a bold stance on owing no man nothing but to love him. So, when it came to purchasing 156 acres of land for our church, I told the people God said to do it debt free. As a small, millennial church, that was in a store front, I'm quite sure many wondered how we would get it done. But when it came time for closing, we had all the money we needed, and we walked away from the signing table owing no man anything but to love him. The scripture says we have according to our faith – Matthew 9:29. Now, this can be walking out of faith as a direct Word from the Lord on how he has planned for you to get it done. Or it can be the exercising of your faith because you find it in the scripture as your covenant right. I want you to know that either way, you will be debt free.

I Thessalonians 4:12 - *That ye may walk honestly toward them that are without, and that ye may have lack of nothing.*

II Corinthians 9:8 AMP - *And God is able to make all grace (every favor and earthly blessing) come to you in abundance, so that you may always and under all circumstances and whatever the need be self-sufficient [possessing enough to require no aid or support and furnished in abundance for every good work and charitable donation].*

Malachi 3:10 - *Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the Lord of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.*

- We give and tithe, not only because God requires it of us, but our giving and tithing position us to owe no man anything. Tithe and

offering are kingdom benefits that yield debt-cancelling returns in our lives.

Proverbs 3:9-10 - *Honour the Lord with thy substance, and with the firstfruits of all thine increase: ¹⁰ so shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine.*

To be “rich” in the Biblical context of the word means to be abundantly supplied. God wants you and I to be abundantly supplied. We are the seed of Abraham who also walk in the faith of Abraham, and God told him and his seed that they would be blessed and be a blessing. The promise is that we would lend unto many nations and not borrow. We can leave an inheritance to our children’s children. We should not leave debts for the next generation without providing them with the abilities to pay those debts.

II King 4:1-7 - A prophet was faithful in service, but for whatever reason, he left his family in debt and the creditors were there to take his children for ransom of the debt. The wife of the prophet came to Elisha for help, and Elisha gave the woman a debt free plan. She paid off the debt, and she and her children lived off the rest. Notice the prophet Elijah’s plan for her life was to relieve her of owing.

Once we know what the words says, we can apply our faith to it. You can live either way: having enough to cover the debt or paying the debt totally off. In either instance, you are debt free.

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- As a Kingdom citizen, you should owe no man anything but to love him.
- You should want to pay your debts on time.
- You can live a life of owing no one.
- Giving affords you a debt free lifestyle.

Kingdom Commitment

- Become disciplined in paying off debts and paying debts on time.

Bind the Strongman

Day #18

Matthew 18:18 AMP - *Truly I tell you, whatever you forbid and declare to be improper and unlawful on earth must be what is already forbidden in heaven, and whatever you permit and declare proper and lawful on earth must be what is already permitted in heaven.*

Luke 10:19 AMP - *Behold! I have given you authority and power to trample upon serpents and scorpions, and [physical and mental strength and ability] over all the power that the enemy [possesses]; and nothing shall in any way harm you.*

1. There is an enemy who does not want to see you prosper in life. This is the outside enemy. He comes to steal, kill, and to destroy. Your key to victory over him is to bind him from operation and to stay clear of his antics of getting you caught in his trap of poverty, debt, and generational lack: **I Peter 5:8-9**, *Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour: ⁹ whom resist steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world.*
 - You have to resist him, which means that his method of operation is not always evil in the sense of something seen to cause harm. He is a sifter. Satan is willing to take his time to get you in his grips. Watch out for the things that are not sinful. It is every weight and sin that besets you.
2. You also have an enemy within that you must take control over. That enemy is your flesh that is unwilling to submit to the divine order of God. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak. It wants what it wants when it wants it and does not consider the consequences thereof. It must be brought under subjection and trained in doing life the right way: **Matthew 26:41**, *Watch and*

pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.

You have opposing forces working against you and you have to bind both. One is outside wanting to get in and the other is the enemy within. To bind means to *confine, restrain, to put under legal authority. It means to obligate.* You are told to resist the devil and bind his workings of spiritual restraint. However, to bind oneself is to live a disciplined life - a life led by the Spirit and Word of God. This may also involve the need to put your money under legal authority, such as a budget or financial counselor until you are disciplined enough, or even direct deposits that help you in paying bills on time.

The strongman is only as strong to the degree of strength you allow him to have over you. The flesh must be tamed and crucified daily.

James 4:7 - *Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.*

- Are there any avenues that you are giving to the enemy that allows him the freedom of access into your financial affairs?
 - Disorderly habits?
 - Disobedient to the Holy Spirit's leading?
 - Non-tither (it rebukes the devourer)?
 - Unrighteous living?
 - Lack of faith?

I Corinthians 11:31AMP - *For if we searchingly examined ourselves [detecting our shortcomings and recognizing our own condition], we should not be judged, and penalty decreed [by the divine judgment].*

- Are there things you are personally not doing that could be binding your finances?
 - Overspending?
 - Spending and not saving?
 - No budget?
 - The lack of financial discipline?
 - Unrenewed mindset concerning wealth and prosperity?

- Negative words?

Until you have done a personal observation of how you handle your personal finances, you cannot put the blame anywhere else. You may be your own hold-up in not seeing the blessings of God manifest in your life.

Luke 16:11 - *If therefore ye have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, how will ye commit to your trust the true riches?*

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- There are two opposing threats to being prosperous.
- I must bind the enemy and bring my flesh under subjection.
- I must look over my life to see if I have control over my financial well-being.
- I have control over my financial outcome.

Kingdom Commitment

- Avoid disorderly spending habits.
- Keeping a confession of faith over my finances.
- Commit to financial discipline of sowing, saving, then spending

The Grace of Giving

II Corinthians 9:6-8, *But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully. ⁷ Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver. ⁸ And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work.*

Testimony: I had a very lucrative business before I was called to pastor. Even before then, I was a giver. Before I had the revelation of giving, I was doing it. I was raised by my grandfather, and I saw how he not only took care of his own home, but how various people from the neighborhood would come and my grandfather would give to their needs. He was a giving man. I understand now why he and my grandmother lived such amazing lives. My grandfather bought all his children their first homes and cars. I had an amazing pattern.

My grandfather was also well-respected in the community and the church. I remember going into the store where my grandfather would buy his bricks and many had to pay, but the man would tell the worker to just load the bricks on my grandfather's truck and that he would pay later. It became clear to me later in life, looking back on all those moments, that my grandfather lived the life he lived because he was a generous man. I would see him give much money to the church. Because he was a brick mason by trade, he would personally take care of every structural need of the church out of his pocket, including the supplies needed to get the job done. I saw a man whose house was next door to the church and who disliked the church, fall in love with my grandfather. He would not allow anyone to park in front of his house during church service. The church offered to purchase the land, but the man strongly refused. But before the man passed, he gave, (That's right, GAVE!) my grandfather the deeds to the house and

property. Being the generous man that he was, my grandfather turned it over to the church.

Our family was noted as being a rich family in our community. The Robinsons was a well-known name, and my grandfather was a much sought-out brick mason. My grandmother wore the finest of clothes and stayed driving a new car. Life was really good. But I now know that it was a principle of generosity being worked way back then.

The grace of giving should not only take place in the house of the Lord. Kingdom people should be givers by nature. Giving is a part of our new created being. It is a lifestyle. Many miss it because they look for moments and, even then, they question whether they should. If you see generosity as who you are and what you do, you will set a continual flow of seedtime and harvest in motion.

II Corinthians 9:10-12AMP - *And [God] Who provides seed for the sower and bread for eating will also provide and multiply your [resources for] sowing and increase the fruits of your righteousness which manifests itself in active goodness, kindness, and charity.* ¹¹ *Thus you will be enriched in all things and in every way, so that you can be generous, and [your generosity as it is] administered by us will bring forth thanksgiving to God.* ¹² *For the service that the ministering of this fund renders does not only fully supply what is lacking to the saints (God's people), but it also overflows in many [cries of] thanksgiving to God.*

Fast-forward: Now I am grown, and I find myself giving freely. It was not until I got in church and began to study the Word that I learned this spirit of generosity had come on me because of seeing my grandfather being such a willing and ready giver. Once I learned it was Biblical and that it held great reward, I pressed in even further. When God told me to shut down my shop and to go into ministry full-time, it was this grace of giving that held my family together. I had no job, but I had this principle from the Word of God that promised me if I gave, God would make all grace abound toward me, so that I would have need of nothing and if there were a need, He would see to it that it was taken care of. When I am asked what's the secret to the success, I am

quick to question the person on their giving record. Many want the prosperity that God has for them but are unwilling to do what the Word says in order for them to see it.

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- Do you see giving as a loss or gain?
- Do you struggle with giving?
- Are you demonstrating a life that can be patterned for the good?

Kingdom Commitment

- Become free in giving.
- Work the principle of giving so that my life remains fruitful.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

Psalms 115:12-15 - *The Lord hath been mindful of us: He will bless us; He will bless the house of Israel; He will bless the house of Aaron. ¹³ He will bless them that fear the Lord, both small and great. ¹⁴ The Lord shall increase you more and more, you and your children. ¹⁵ Ye are blessed of the Lord which made heaven and earth.*

Isaiah 45:2-3,25 - *I will go before thee, and make the crooked places straight: I will break in pieces the gates of brass, and cut in sunder the bars of iron: ³ and I will give thee the treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places, that thou mayest know that I, the Lord, which call thee by thy name, am the God of Israel.*

²⁵ *In the Lord shall all the seed of Israel be justified and shall glory.*

Isaiah 48:17 - *Thus saith the Lord, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; I am the Lord thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go.*

- If He were not a God who wanted us to prosper, why would He teach us how to and, in another scripture, give us the power (the ability) to get wealth?

Psalms 35:27 - *Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour My righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the Lord be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of His servant.*

Deuteronomy 8:18 - *But thou shalt remember the Lord thy God: for it is He that giveth thee power to get wealth, that He may establish his covenant which He sware unto thy fathers, as it is this day.*

Mark 10:28-30 - *Then Peter began to say unto him, Lo, we have left all, and have followed thee.²⁹ And Jesus answered and said, Verily I say unto you, **There is no man that hath left** house, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my sake, and the gospel's,³⁰ **but he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time**, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, with persecutions; and in the world to come eternal life.*

Proverbs 10:22 AMP - *The blessing of the Lord - **it makes [truly] rich**, and He adds no sorrow with it [neither does toiling increase it].*

- His name is El Shaddai, which means the God of Abundance. The God that is More than Enough. In our English language, we say He is the Almighty God.

Genesis 17:1 - *And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the Lord appeared to Abram and said unto him, I am the **Almighty God**; walk before Me and be thou perfect.*

God is the God of Abundance! Abundance is His name, and His name reveals His character. Poverty, lack, famine, and scarcity are not the will of God, neither are they the plan of God for your life. God wants to show Himself strong on your behalf. Your very life speaks of His goodness.

II Chronicles 16:9 - *For the eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth to show Himself strong in behalf of those whose hearts are blameless toward Him. You have done foolishly in this; therefore, from now on you shall have wars.*

- We walk by faith and not by sight. The scripture declares that when we come to God in faith, we must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him - Hebrews 11:6. So even in our coming to God, He wants us reward-focused. He can meet

and supply every need in your life. Apostle I.V. Hilliard says it like this, "God can afford your dreams."

Hebrews 11:6 - *But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.*

- God loved us and sent Jesus to die for our sins so that we might be saved. The very same body that carried our sins on the Cross, carried poverty. So, just like we would not have to experience death in sin, we would not have to experience poverty on earth.

II Corinthians 8:9 - *For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.*

- Do not discount nor discredit God. Come boldly to God! He wants to be God to you in all areas of life. There is not a need that God is unable to meet, including a financial one.

Hebrews 4:16 - *Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.*

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- God is a God of abundance.
- Poverty and lack are not the will of God.
- God wants us to prosper in life.
- God is concerned about your financial state.

Kingdom Commitment

- NEVER underestimate who God is and what God can do!
- Bring my finances under the Kingdom of Heaven.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

Prosperity Minded 1

Day #21

Romans 12:2 - *And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.*

“Transformed” - This word deals with the nature of a thing. It means to undergo a change, restructure, or modification.

“Renew” - The Word conveys the picture of a demolition; a going in and breaking up the foundation of something; to establish and lay a new foundation to be built upon.

“That ye may prove” - Until transformation and renewing takes place, you will not prove. Prove means to demonstrate the truth or existence of by evidence.

You have to become increase and multiplication minded. The ones who were given the talent and multiplied them did so because they had an increase mentality. The servant who was given one talent went and hid his one. He did not have an increase mentality; thus, he could not see the potential in the one. When you have an increase mentality, you attract increase.

1. The mind is not readily in agreement with the will of God. It was your spirit man that got saved. You now hold the responsibility of renewing your mind to God's way of thinking and doing. It is with the renewed mind that we prove what is that good, acceptable, and perfect will of God is. The carnal mind (a mind untrained in God's way) cannot understand the ways of God. This is why you must renew your mind to the place where your spirit was saved.
2. You will experience life to the degree of your belief. You are designed to do what you believe you can and to be who you believe you are. Even though the Word of God calls you a royal priesthood and says that you are free from sin and condemnation, if you have

not renewed your mind so that it comes into agreement with what God says, you will live like you are in bondage although you are free.

Ephesians 4:23-24 - *And be renewed in the spirit of your mind; ²⁴ and that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.*

Spirit of your mind - This statement refers to the seat of your beliefs. The responses that we often give to life's situations have already been predetermined. There are many contributing factors that aid in the development of our beliefs, such as culture, what we were taught, our experiences, and things we picked up in life along the way. These help to set beliefs in us whether they were true or untrue. If those things were not measured by the Word of God and they are in you as a foundational truth, then they are against the will of God and not for the will of God. Consequently, there will be contention in obeying the Word and understanding the Word when there is a considered truth already in the way.

3. You will not understand the ways of the Bible with an unrenewed mind. The renewed mind causes you to walk in the new man.

I Corinthians 2:14 - *But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.*

Today's Financial Fast is about you examining the seat of your belief as it pertains to prosperity.

Mark 7:13 - *Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.*

- Do you believe in being prosperous?
- Were disciplines taught to you growing up on being prosperous and handling money?
- What does it mean to have money?
- How much do you know about generational wealth?

- Does your savings receive money every time you get paid?
- Do you struggle with finances (*Saving, Spending, holding on to*)?

We can believe we are prosperity-minded when we actually aren't. We can be ready for something in our conscious, but are we ready for it in the seat of our belief - our conscience (the place of stored knowledge and the place of our belief)? Without a renewed mind, you will be handling more money with the same mind that you currently have. This means, with more money, you will only do what you are currently doing.

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- Your mind matters.
- You will produce what you think.

Kingdom Commitment

Read Chapter 11

Kingdom Wealth Confession

I open the eyes of my understanding to be renewed into the image of God's Son, Jesus. Prosperity Minded 2

Day #22

III John 1:2 - *Beloved, I wish above all things **that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.***

You will have and experience life to the degree of your ability to believe. This is not a believing for the moment, but what you have settled as truth in your heart. According to the scripture, your health (your wellbeing) is connected to the mindset you have about being healthy. It is true that we are promised long life, health, and healing, but is your belief system established on what God said?

“Even as your soul prospers” - The key to prospering starts in the mind. You have to know and believe that it is God’s will for you to prosper. Once you know the truth, and believe and receive it as your truth, then you must think on those things regardless of what the situation may look like. It is the truth you believe that will be the truth you manifest.

Mark 4:20 - *And these are they which are sown on good ground; such as hear the word, and receive it, and bring forth fruit, some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some an hundred.*

Mark 9:23 - *Jesus said unto him, if thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.*

Things become possible when you believe. When we look through the Bible, we see the different outcomes of those who believed and those who did not believe. Note, the outcome did not happen simply because God said. The outcome was the result of how they believed.

Romans 10:9-10: You got saved because you believed and confessed.

Mark 6:5: Jesus was hindered from doing great and mighty works because of the people’s unbelief.

Matthew 8:7: The centurion's servant got healed because the centurion believed that if Jesus just spoke the word only, his servant would be healed.

Hebrews 3:19: Over two million Hebrew people died in the wilderness and missed a promised land God prepared for them because of their unbelief.

Hebrews 4:3: There is a rest awaiting those who can believe.

Mark 9:23: If you can believe, all things are possible.

"Soul Prospers" - You were given a soul (a mind, will, emotions, intellect, and an imagination). This is what the seat of your belief system consists of, and each part plays an intricate role in you having a prosperous mind and in the development of your faith.

1. Intellect - Understanding of the Word of God at my level of comprehension. The more I read and study the Word, the more I gain an understanding of the Word for my soul to prosper intellectually.
2. Emotions - Emotions are real but cannot be trusted; however, the conscience receives whatever you tie your emotions to as truth.
3. Mind - The mind is shaped by words so you must speak what you want and not what you see.
4. Imagination - The same words I speak begin to paint the picture of being prosperous on the canvas of my imagination, which fuels my emotions to find the right relationships, knowledge, people, and things to bring it to pass.
5. Will - My very action has a targeted outcome. I believe I am prosperous; thus, my faith summons the supernatural power of God to assist me in becoming who I believe I am. In the secular world, they would call this a made-up mind. I say it's a prosperous mind. A prosperous mind speaks prosperous. You cannot speak defeat and lack and have faith for increase and abundance at the same time. A prosperous mind will produce a prosperous outcome. A negative mind will produce a negative outcome.

Kingdom Prosperous Mind Exercise

Mark 11:24 - *Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.*

To have a prosperous mind, you must connect your desires to your belief. Desires cannot only be something you would like to have; they must become the things you believe you can have. This will go against the religious norm of *if God wants you to have it*. The scripture said it is what you desire when you pray. In praying, you must believe it.

The exercise below is designed to bring your soul in alignment with your beliefs. Desires do not have to be achievable by you. The scripture only says that they have to be believable.

Setting in Motion the Supernatural

Day #23

Genesis 26:1-4,12-14 - *And there was a famine in the land, beside the first famine that was in the days of Abraham. And Isaac went unto Abimelech king of the Philistines unto Gerar. ² And the Lord appeared unto him, and said, Go not down into Egypt; dwell in the land which I shall tell thee of: ³ sojourn in this land, and I will be with thee, and will bless thee; for unto thee, and unto thy seed, I will give all these countries, and I will perform the oath which I sware unto Abraham thy father; ⁴ and I will make thy seed to multiply as the stars of heaven, and will give unto thy seed all these countries; and in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed.*

¹² Then Isaac sowed in that land, and received in the same year an hundredfold: and the Lord blessed him. ¹³ And the man waxed great, and went forward, and grew until he became very great: ¹⁴ for he had possession of flocks, and possession of herds, and great store of servants: and the Philistines envied him.

Psalms 1:3 - *And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.*

John 6:11 - *And Jesus took the loaves; and when he had given thanks, he distributed to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were set down; and likewise of the fishes as much as they would.*

Philippians 4:16-19 - *For even in Thessalonica ye sent once and again unto my necessity. ¹⁷ Not because I desire a gift: but I desire fruit that may abound to your account. ¹⁸ But I have all, and abound: I am full, having received of Epaphroditus the things which were sent from you, an odour of a sweet smell, a sacrifice acceptable, wellpleasing to God. ¹⁹ But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.*

The Believer operates by a different system than the world. Believers are under the economy of the Kingdom. This economy has benefits that advance those that abide therein. Because of this righteous position, we are sourced and resourced from another world. This place provides an unlimited supply for the Believer for every need in earth.

Matthew 6:30-33 - *Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith? ³¹ Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? ³² (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things. ³³ But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.*

Through application of the principles of God (the Word), the Believer taps into that Heavenly economy that overrides any deficiency you might face.

1. *Genesis 26:1-4,12-14* - Isaac was in the midst of a double famine. The commonsense thing to do was to leave that place and go find supply. God told him to stay and trust the Heavenly economy. Isaac activated the Heavenly economy and sowed and in the same year, while in the famine, reaped 100-fold and multiplied exceedingly. His sowing invited God to intervene on his not enough and turned it into more than enough.
2. *Psalms 1:3* - Promises that in no season should we wither, and in whatever we do that God ordains, it will prosper. God partners with Kingdom efforts and causes the Believer to do more with less time, less money, and half the effort.
3. *John 6:11* - Jesus took the fish that were not enough and presented it to God as a seed. God got involved and multiplied the fish, and the people ate as much as they wanted. Jesus partnered with the Kingdom's economy by presenting an offering to God, and God multiplied the seed sown.

4. *Philippians 4:16-19* - The people sowed into the Apostle Paul's life, activating the principle of seedtime harvest. Paul declared that they activated the Kingdom's economy to get active on their behalf, now my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory. Notice, it was now from the riches of God that the needs of the people would be met.
5. *Matthew 6:30-33* - The scripture says that there are things in the Kingdom - things we would need on earth to carry out life. It guarantees us that if we seek God's way of getting them, all things will be added unto us. This is the promise of no lack of anything.
6. *Luke 6:38* - When you sow into the Kingdom of God, you reap the Kingdom of God - good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over.

The Believer is not limited in resources or help. The limit is in faith to believe and act on the Word of God, which invites the outpour of Heaven's resource. This outpour is the supernatural. It is when God intervenes in our earthly affairs and causes the unexplainable to happen. The supernatural is when we put God first, and His response is that we experience the exceeding, abundantly, above all we can ask or think.

- **Believe for more than enough.**
- **Expand your faith for more than enough.**
- **Challenge your mind to think bigger.**

Isaiah 54:2-3 - *Enlarge the place of thy tent, and let them stretch forth the curtains of thine habitations: spare not, lengthen thy cords, and strengthen thy stakes; ³ for thou shalt break forth on the right hand and on the left; and thy seed shall inherit the Gentiles, and make the desolate cities to be inhabited.*

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- You always have a means of supply, even when it does not naturally look like it.

- The economy of the Kingdom has an endless supply. And by faith, you can tap into it.
- God's Kingdom is not governed or regulated by the world.
- When you sow, you should expect supernatural things to happen.

Kingdom Commitment

- Focus more on what the Kingdom affords than what you must work to attain in earth.
- Put Heaven to work.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

I am of the God-class.

I walk by faith and not by sight.

I activate Heaven's economy by my giving, and the windows of Heaven give rain unto my land.

Others will know that I am God's child.

The blessing is on my life! Favor is on my life! I am winning!

In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Anointed To Prosper

Day #24

Genesis 1:28 - *And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.*

Deuteronomy 28:12 - *The Lord shall open unto thee His good treasure, the heaven to give the rain unto thy land in his season, and to bless all the work of thine hand: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not borrow.*

II Chronicles 26:5 - *And he sought God in the days of Zechariah, who had understanding in the visions of God: and as long as he sought the Lord, God made him to prosper.*

John 15:16 - *Ye have not chosen Me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in My Name, He may give it you.*

You are a wealth magnet. You were anointed to prosper. The word anoint means *smear on*. When anointed, you are the thing that was smeared on. The anointing is the yoke-destroying, burden-removing power of God. Every Christian is anointed to defeat debt, lack, scarcity, and poverty. When God created the first man, he created him to be fruitful and have dominion. This ability was never lost; it just wasn't exercised. God is so motivated that you prosper, He says every branch that doesn't bear fruit He will either purge it or cut it off – John 15:2.

- John 15:8 - It is to the glory of God that we bear much fruit.
- Matthew 5:16 - When our lights shine, the world sees our good works and glorifies God. Our lack brings no glory to God. Believers have been anointed to be lenders and not the borrower.

There should be no question in the mind of the Believer of whether he can prosper. Salvation has equipped us with a God-given ability to prosper in the land. Prospering is God's promise to us. It was of His will that He chose us to this life. The righteous should not take back or cower from how God made us.

Psalms 68:19 - *Blessed be the Lord, who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our salvation. Selah.*

John 10:10 - *The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it overflows).*

Psalms 92:12-15 - *The righteous shall flourish like the palm tree: he shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon. ¹³ Those that be planted in the house of the Lord shall flourish in the courts of our God. ¹⁴ They shall still bring forth fruit in old age; they shall be fat and flourishing; ¹⁵ to shew that the Lord is upright: He is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in Him.*

The Church is the body of Christ. Jesus is the head. If the body lacks, then it is the reflection of the head. Jesus does not lack, so neither shall His body. Jesus is the Anointed One, and if we are the body, we are partakers of the same anointing. It was when we were without Christ that we were strangers, aliens, and foreigners from His covenant and promises. But now, we are fellow citizens to the covenant, the commonwealth of promise, and of the household of God.

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- I am a wealth magnet!
- I am anointed to prosper.
- God is glorified when I prosper.
- The Father wants to freely give me all things.
- I can believe for and expect more than enough.

Kingdom Commitment

- No longer accept mediocre!

- Just enough is not enough and nonoptional.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

I am anointed to prosper. I accept and walk in God's will for my life. I live a life of purpose, saying what I want and not what I see. I am a good steward and God can trust me. I resist lack! You are the God of abundance, and because Jesus is Lord over my life, I live the abundant life that He came to bring so that I might have. Wealth and resources, come to me! Prosperity, come to me! Favor, come to me! I release my ministering angels to go now and bring wealth my way. I release those to be free to give into my life, for I am good ground and the righteous seed of Abraham. I prosper wherever I go, and I increase to the glory of God. I believe and I receive by faith,

Wealth Transfer

Day #25

Joel 2:25 - *And I will restore to you the years that the locust hath eaten, the cankerworm, and the caterpillar, and the palmerworm, my great army which I sent among you.*

Isaiah 54:2-3 - *Enlarge the place of thy tent, and let them stretch forth the curtains of thine habitations: spare not, lengthen thy cords, and strengthen thy stakes; ³ for thou shalt break forth on the right hand and on the left; and thy seed shall inherit the Gentiles, and make the desolate cities to be inhabited.*

Isaiah 60:10-14 - *And the sons of strangers shall build up thy walls, and their kings shall minister unto thee: for in My wrath I smote thee, but in My favour have I had mercy on thee. ¹¹ Therefore thy gates shall be open continually; they shall not be shut day nor night; that men may bring unto thee the forces of the Gentiles, and that their kings may be brought. ¹² For the nation and kingdom that will not serve thee shall perish; yea, those nations shall be utterly wasted. ¹³ The glory of Lebanon shall come unto thee, the fir tree, the pine tree, and the box together, to beautify the place of my sanctuary; and I will make the place of my feet glorious. ¹⁴ The sons also of them that afflicted thee shall come bending unto thee; and all they that despised thee shall bow themselves down at the soles of thy feet; and they shall call thee, The city of the Lord, The Zion of the Holy One of Israel.*

Isaiah 61:4-7 - *And they shall build the old wastes, they shall raise up the former desolations, and they shall repair the waste cities, the desolations of many generations. ⁵ And strangers shall stand and feed your flocks, and the sons of the alien shall be your plowmen and your vinedressers. ⁶ But ye shall be named the Priests of the Lord: men shall call you the Ministers of our God: ye shall eat the riches of the Gentiles, and in their glory shall ye boast yourselves. ⁷ For your shame ye shall have double; and for confusion they shall rejoice in their portion:*

therefore in their land they shall possess the double: everlasting joy shall be unto them.

Haggai 2:6-9 - *For thus saith the Lord of hosts; Yet once, it is a little while, and I will shake the heavens, and the earth, and the sea, and the dry land; ⁷ and I will shake all nations, and the desire of all nations shall come: and I will fill this house with glory, saith the Lord of hosts. ⁸ The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, saith the Lord of hosts. ⁹ The glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former, saith the Lord of hosts: and in this place will I give peace, saith the Lord of hosts.*

Proverbs 13:22 AMP - *A good man leaves an inheritance [of moral stability and goodness] to his children's children, and the wealth of the sinner [finds its way eventually] into the hands of the righteous, for whom it was laid up.*

Ecclesiastes 2:26 NLT - *God gives wisdom, knowledge, and joy to those who please him. But if a sinner becomes wealthy, God takes the wealth away and gives it to those who please him. This, too, is meaningless - like chasing the wind.*

Psalms 105:37 AMP - *He brought [Israel] forth also with silver and gold, and there was not one feeble person among their tribes.*

A transfer is when something is taken from one place and put or given to another. The Bible tells us that God is redistributing wealth out of the hands of the unrighteous/the sinner into the hands of the righteous.

1. There is a transfer that is happening and there must be an expectation from the Church for the transfer.
2. There must be a faith released from the Church for wealth. All the promises of God are received by faith. With faith, we can receive supernatural increase so that for life, Kingdom assignments and projects can be successful.

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- There is wealth that is in the wrong hands.
- God did not intend for you to have to work to get all your needs met.
- You have a responsibility to the welfare of the next generation.

Kingdom Commitment

- Believe that God can provide beyond natural means.
- No longer limit God in how He can provide.
- Expect increase from unexpected places.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

The wealth of the wicked is transferred to me.

I enlarge my tent and my expectation for greater.

I abound in blessings.

I receive increase from unexpected places and unexpected people.

I am a money magnet. People love giving to me.

Because I am the righteous, my hands are blessed and anointed to receive wealth.

Money and more money are coming my way.

In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Jehovah Jireh Day #26

Genesis 22:14 - *And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovah-Jireh: as it is said to this day, In the mount of the Lord it shall be seen.*

NCV - *So Abraham named that place The Lord Provides. Even today people say, "On the mountain of the Lord it will be provided."*

Jehovah Jireh means, "*The Lord God who Provides.*"

The root word Jireh means to see, but when you combine Jehovah, it means provide. What God is really showing us is that He is God who has gone ahead of us and already provided what we need in life, because He saw before we needed.

Isaiah 65:24 NLT - *I will answer them before they even call to Me. While they are still talking about their needs, I will go ahead and answer their prayers!*

Psalms 23:1-3 AMP - *¹ The Lord is my Shepherd [to feed, guide, and shield me], I shall not lack. ² He makes me lie down in [fresh, tender] green pastures; He leads me beside the still and restful waters. ³ He refreshes and restores my life (my self); He leads me in the paths of righteousness [uprightness and right standing with Him - not for my earning it, but] for His name's sake.*

Psalms 34:10 NCV - *Even lions may get weak and hungry, but those who look to the Lord will have every good thing.*

Psalms 68:19 - *Blessed be the Lord, who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our salvation. Selah.*

Ephesians 2:10 AMP - *For we are God's [own] handiwork (His workmanship), recreated in Christ Jesus, [born anew] that we may do those good works which God predestined (planned beforehand) for us [taking paths which He prepared ahead of time], that we should walk in*

them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us to live].

Philippians 4:19 AMP - *And my God will liberally supply (fill to the full) your every need according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.*

Deuteronomy 2:7 - *For the Lord thy God hath blessed thee in all the works of thy hand: He knoweth thy walking through this great wilderness: these forty years the Lord thy God hath been with thee; thou hast lacked nothing.*

Luke 22:35 - *And he said unto them, When I sent you without purse, and scrip, and shoes, lacked ye any thing? And they said, Nothing.*

John 10:10 AMP - *The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it overflows).*

You are a Kingdom citizen. An heir of God and a joint heir with Christ. Let's hear that another way: You are an heir with Jehovah-Jireh and a joint heir with Jehovah-Jireh. You have a direct connection with the One who can provide all your needs. The righteous is NEVER forsaken, nor does his seed beg for bread. You are blessed of the Lord [Jehovah Jireh], who made Heaven and earth.

Be bold in your belief of who guards and Lord's your life. He is a provider. He has already seen ahead and prepared everything you need for you.

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- Jehovah Jireh has provided for my life.
- Provision is a covenant right to me, not based on my goodness, but on His.
- The Lord is my Provider.

Kingdom Commitment

- See and believe upon God for who He is apart from my actions.

- Trust that God is who He says He is. He is The Lord who Provides!

Kingdom Wealth Confession

I cast down all imaginations and remove all restraints that hinder God from operating in my life. You are my provider, and I trust in You to guide me in the way I should go. The Lord is my help and the sustainer of my life. I lack nothing. I have all sufficiency in all things and my cup runneth over. No longer do I accept defeat or delay in my financial progress. Jehovah Jireh provides for all my needs.

Heart Posture

Day #27

What is your real motivation for wanting to be prosperous? It is your motivation that defines the posture you will take when you have it.

Genesis 14:20-23 - *And blessed be the Most High God, which hath delivered thine enemies into thy hand. And he gave him tithes of all. ²¹ And the king of Sodom said unto Abram, Give me the persons, and take the goods to thyself. ²² And Abram said to the king of Sodom, I have lift up mine hand unto the Lord, the Most High God, the possessor of heaven and earth, ²³ that I will not take from a thread even to a shoelatchet, and that I will not take any thing that is thine, lest thou shouldest say, I have made Abram rich.*

I Chronicles 29:10-14 - *Wherefore David blessed the Lord before all the congregation: and David said, Blessed be thou, Lord God of Israel our father, for ever and ever. ¹¹ Thine, O Lord, is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is thine; thine is the kingdom, O Lord, and thou art exalted as head above all. ¹² Both riches and honour come of thee, and thou reignest over all; and in thine hand is power and might; and in thine hand it is to make great, and to give strength unto all. ¹³ Now therefore, our God, we thank thee, and praise thy glorious name. ¹⁴ But who am I, and what is my people, that we should be able to offer so willingly after this sort? for all things come of thee, and of thine own have we given thee.*

Proverbs 3:9-10 NLT - *Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the best part of everything you produce. ¹⁰ Then He will fill your barns with grain, and your vats will overflow with good wine.*

Proverbs 13:22 - *A good man leaveth an inheritance to his children's children: and the wealth of the sinner is laid up for the just.*

Malachi 3:10 - *Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in Mine house, and prove Me now herewith, saith the Lord of Hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.*

I Timothy 6:17-19 AMP - *As for the rich in this world, charge them not to be proud and arrogant and contemptuous of others, nor to set their hopes on uncertain riches, but on God, Who richly and ceaselessly provides us with everything for [our] enjoyment. ¹⁸ [Charge them] to do good, to be rich in good works, to be liberal and generous of heart, ready to share [with others], ¹⁹ In this way laying up for themselves [the riches that endure forever as] a good foundation for the future, so that they may grasp that which is life indeed.*

Luke 12:18-21 - *And he said, This will I do: I will pull down my barns, and build greater; and there will I bestow all my fruits and my goods. ¹⁹ And I will say to my soul, Soul, thou hast much goods laid up for many years; take thine ease, eat, drink, and be merry. ²⁰ But God said unto him, Thou fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided? ²¹ So is he that layeth up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God.*

Matthew 6:19-21 AMP - *Do not gather and heap up and store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust and worm consume and destroy, and where thieves break through and steal. ²⁰ But gather and heap up and store for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust nor worm consume and destroy, and where thieves do not break through and steal; ²¹ For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.*

Mark 10:23-24 - *And Jesus looked round about, and saith unto His disciples, How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the kingdom of God! ²⁴ And the disciples were astonished at his words. But Jesus answereth again, and saith unto them, Children, how hard is it for them that trust in riches to enter into the kingdom of God!*

Luke 12:15 - *And He said unto them, Take heed and beware of covetousness; for a man's life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth.*

1. The posture of those in the Kingdom with riches is steward, not owner. It is the position of being equipped by God for His use towards Kingdom expansion. Believers do not take an owner's mentality. When the Christian maintains the right posture, they do not have to worry about greed, pride, covetousness, or becoming a lover of money. Humility is found in this posture.
2. The real motivation for the accumulation of wealth should be to glorify God. When you see yourself as the distributor and not the owner, it is easier to obey God when He calls for what He has put into your possession.

II Corinthians 6:10 - *as sorrowful, yet alway rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing all things.*

3. Truly rich is when you set your affections on God's agenda. Looking away from you does not mean that your needs are not met and that you cannot enjoy the abundant life. But when you only heap riches unto yourself or desire to be rich for your own desires, you have missed the purpose of being prosperous.

Luke 10:29-37 - *But he, willing to justify himself, said unto Jesus, And who is my neighbour?³⁰ And Jesus answering said, A certain man went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves, which stripped him of his raiment, and wounded him, and departed, leaving him half dead.³¹ And by chance there came down a certain priest that way: and when he saw him, he passed by on the other side.³² And likewise a Levite, when he was at the place, came and looked on him, and passed by on the other side.³³ But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was: and when he saw him, he had compassion on him,³⁴ and went to him, and bound up his wounds, pouring in oil and wine, and set him on his own beast, and brought him to an inn, and took care of him.³⁵ And on the morrow when he departed, he took out two pence, and gave them to the host, and said unto him, Take care of him; and whatsoever thou spendest more, when I come again, I will repay thee.³⁶ Which now of these three, thinkest thou, was neighbour unto him that fell among the thieves?³⁷ And he said, He that shewed mercy on him. Then said Jesus unto him, Go, and do thou likewise.*

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- Is my heart in the right place for having riches?
- Do I think of helping others and furthering God's Kingdom agenda or am I *me* minded?
- Does my heart reflect the heart of God?
- Am I ready for true riches?

Kingdom Commitment

- Develop a heart that is centered on pleasing God.
- Get the right perspective and purpose for being prosperous.
- Start putting God first now.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

Father, I desire a heart that seeks to please You and put You first above all else. I ask that You create in me a clean heart and renew a right spirit in me, so that my heart posture matches Your will for my life. I make You the Lord of my life, therefore, You have control over my financial affairs.

In Jesus' Name, Amen.

No More Lack

Day #28

Matthew 11:12 - *And from the days of John the Baptist until now the Kingdom of Heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.*

AMP - *And from the days of John the Baptist until the present time, the Kingdom of Heaven has endured violent assault, and violent men seize it by force [as a precious prize - a share in the Heavenly Kingdom is sought with most ardent zeal and intense exertion].*

Hebrews 10:19-23 - *Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus, ²⁰ by a new and living way, which He hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, His flesh; ²¹ and having an high priest over the house of God; ²² let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water. ²³ Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;)*

Hebrews 4:16 - *Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.*

You must take a bold stance when it comes to be financially free. Satan wants nothing more than for God's people to be under the control of mammon. The Spirit of poverty is very aggressive, but your faith is even the more aggressive. Faith is a force that can defeat anything. By it, the elders obtained a good report.

1. The men carrying their friend to be healed by Jesus did not allow the crowd to keep them from getting what they came for. They were aggressive and climbed on the roof to get to Jesus - *Mark 2:1-5*.
2. The woman with the issue of blood had to press through a crowd already thronging Jesus. With her life on the line, she made it

through the press for one touch that healed her instantly - *Mark 5:25-34*.

3. Jacob wrestled with the angel all night and would not let go until he blessed him - *Genesis 32:22-31*.
4. Blind Bartimaeus did not allow them to shut him up, so he cried even louder for Jesus's attention - *Mark 10:46-52*.
5. Jesus endured the Cross and despised the shame to make it back to the throne of glory - *Hebrews 12:1-2*.

In each of these accounts, it took bold, tenacious faith. Each had their faith focused on the desired outcome. You have to look past not enough. Look past debt and lack. Look past where your current financial state is and shout NO MORE LACK! No longer will you settle for what has been. No longer will you settle for mediocrity. No longer will you settle for just enough.

TELL LACK TO GO! POVERTY, GO! FINANCIAL HARDSHIP, GO! Whatever mountain you are facing in your finances, you can speak to it and tell it to BE GONE AND CAST INTO THE SEA, and it MUST OBEY!

You are supposed to reign as king in this life. You are the head and not the tail; above only and not beneath. Jesus died so that you could live the abundant life.

Like Caleb and Joshua, you must have a "let us go up at once, for you are well able to take the land" mindset to **take hold of the abundant life**"

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- Things are the way you allow them to be.
- Once in Christ, poverty is a choice.
- Having a lack free life is Bible and the will of God.
- You will live life by your faith

Kingdom Commitment

- Reject lack and limit living.
- Agree with the Word.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

I reject lack and limit living.

I live an above average lifestyle.

Jesus took lack to the Cross, removing it from the life of the Born-again Believer.

Spirit of poverty and lack, GO FROM ME!

I bind your works and loose you from having any influence over my finances right now!

The curse of lack is broken, and I will never be broke another day in my life.

In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Angelic Assistance

Day #29

Hebrews 1:14 - *Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?*

AMP - *Are not the angels all ministering spirits (servants) sent out in the service [of God for the assistance] of those who are to inherit salvation?*

You have angels assigned to you. Their job is to assist and serve you for the success of all your earthly affairs. Whatever is necessary to bring God's covenant to pass in earth, they are there to assist.

Psalms 103:20 - *Bless the Lord, ye his angels, that excel in strength, that do His commandments, hearkening unto the voice of His Word.*

Angels hearken to the voice of the Word. This means that they are only activated when the Word is spoken. That means that you must know what the Word says concerning your life in that particular area in order to release angelic assistance on your behalf.

Hebrews 13:2 - *Don't forget to show hospitality to strangers, for some who have done this have entertained angels without realizing it!*

It is possible to have engaged an angel and not have known it. As spirit beings, we have access to engage another realm and, from that realm, receive assistance for the betterment of life on earth.

The spiritual blessings in heavenly places are also angels prepared to minister at your request - *Ephesians 1:3*. We often do more work than necessary, because instead of giving our angels an assignment they were created for, prepared, and ready to perform, we do the work ourselves. Employ your ministering angels to go to work on your behalf!

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- You have angels - supernatural help assigned to you.
- Angels minister at your command of the Word.

Kingdom Commitment

- Speak to your ministering angels to go and bring money to you.
- Never let angels stand by! They are ministering spirits sent to minister.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

I declare blessings in my life, in my home, and in my storehouses. I wear the best, eat the best, drive the best, and I go first class. I enjoy the good life, for its God's gift to me. I bind the hand of Satan. I render him powerless, paralyzed, and ineffective against my finances. I release my ministering angels to go now and cause wealth to come my way, send people my way to show favor and opportunity, open doors that were once closed, and close doors that were open to my disadvantage. Bring Heaven's reserve to my home now!

Day #30

II Peter 1:3 AMP - *For His divine power has bestowed upon us all things that [are requisite and suited] to life and godliness, through the [full, personal] knowledge of Him Who called us by and to His own glory and excellence (virtue).*

I John 4:17 - *Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as He is, so are we in this world.*

John 1:16 AMP - *For out of His fullness (abundance) we have all received [all had a share and we were all supplied with] one grace after another and spiritual blessing upon spiritual blessing and even favor upon favor and gift [heaped] upon gift.*

Luke 4:19 - *to preach the acceptable year of the Lord.*

The New Testament speaks to the Believer “as having,” not “as getting” like the Old Testament. You are blessed of the Lord. You have put on Christ. It is now a matter of you walking as the new man. The Bible says we grow up into Him. This means we have the fullness of God in us, and we must grow into what is already on the inside of us.

We have all things that pertain to life and godliness. What is needed is the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, so that the eyes of our understanding (spirit eyes) are enlightened (to see and understand plainly,) so that through operation of revelation we get manifestation.

YOU ARE PROSPEROUS! Spiritual truth and consciousness always come before natural results. You must see yourself as being prosperous, without any sense realm evidence. Faith is always evidence not seen before it's on the scene.

Romans 12:2 - *And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.*

Joshua 1:8 - *This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.*

1. *Hebrews 11:1* - Now faith is Faith is always in the now, the present tense. Faith says, "I am, I have." Hope is a future expectation. We walk by faith [now] not by hope [future]. By faith you believe you are - not that you are going to be.
2. *Mark 10:24* - You believe you have received (past present tense) when we pray. So, we have it spiritually before we see it naturally.

Faith calls those things that be not as though they were. You are prosperous now. You shall have what you believe you receive. Jesus found where it was written of Him what He was sent to do and what the anointing was on Him to perform, and His reply after reading was, "This day is the scripture fulfilled in your hearing." Approach the Word the same way: Read it. Believe it. Claim it as so.

This fast is about you totally immersing yourself in the Word of God, so that total mind renewal takes place. Life will become the expression of your beliefs. Beliefs are development through the processing of information. Whatever you ruminate on, you become internally. And whatever information holds the seat of your belief internally will factor in the production of your external, regardless of what God says you are.

You must listen to prosperity long enough until it purges any question of whether you can be prosperous or whether you should have more. The lack mentality must be broken, and this can only happen through repetition of the right information. Your very thoughts must become rooted in the truth of Kingdom wealth.

Kingdom Fasting Thought

- I am what the Word says I am.
- Faith is claiming it as so NOW.
- There must be spiritual truth before natural results.
- I will manifest life at the level of my faith.

Kingdom Commitment

- Let the Word be the truth and final authority.
- Get immersed in the Word.

Kingdom Wealth Confession

I am prosperous!

I am blessed and favored of the Lord.

I am rich and abundantly supplied.

I am of the seed of Abraham; redeemed from the curse of the law; purchased by the blood of Christ; seated in heavenly places with Christ; and overcoming the world by faith.

I prosper wherever I go.

As Jesus is, so am I in this life.

I receive 100-fold now in this time and in the world to come - eternal life.
